## YACHT RACES ON IN BARNEGAT BAY

Full Program Promises Aquatic

Sport For Young and Old.

TOMS RIVER, July 10.—Yacht rac-ing on Barnegat bay is in full swing. The first races of the season were held on June 27. At least two races each week will be held. The Bay Head club was the first to race under the auspices of the Barnegat Bay Yacht Rac-

ing association.

The Bay Head club and the Island Heights Yacht club have mapped out a full schedule of events for the sum-

The regatta committee of the Bay Head Yacht club has scheduled 35 races, to be sailed over the courses of the Bay Head club, the Mantoloking club, Sea Side Park club, Island Heights club and the Lavalette club. The Bay Head club pennant will be awarded to the sneakbox and one de-sign boats making the highest num-ber of points during the

ber of points during the summer.

Points are awarded in the order in which the boats finish, the first boat setting 5 points, second three and the third two points.

The junior races will be held this year as follows:

year as follows:

On the first and third Mondays in
July and August, one design races for
boys and girls under 15 years of age.
On alternating Mondays sneakbox
races for boats under 15 feet in length
with crews of boys or girls under 16 years of age.

The first and third Wednesdays will The first and third Wednesdays will see races for boys and girls under 21 years of age, with boats less than 20 feet in length, and the alternating Wednesdays will be given over to one design races for members 21 years of age or under. On Saturday, July 25, with the exception of the one design race in the morning, there will be no yachting, the usual water sports being planned for that day.
