

One of the big events of the yachting year—a red letter day on the Barnegat Bay yachting calendar—took place on Saturday when the Island Heights Yacht Club pulled off the Morgan cup race. The trophy is one of the handsomest and costliest, and is a perpetual prize, to be sailed for each July by the catboats in the Island Heights, Seaside Park, Bay Head and Mantoloking yacht clubs. It is now held by former Assemblyman Harry R. Buxton, of Bay Head, who won it last July with his Bailey-designed Romp. The Morgan cup, unlike the Sewell cup, which has never been won at Bay Head, has gone up the bay club twice, once taken by Romp and once by Hummer. The prize was given some ten years ago by the late State Comptroller, J. Willard Morgan, of Camden. Many local lovers of the aquatic sports witnessed the close and exciting contests.
