

CONNECT BARNEGAT WITH MANASQUAN

Trnton, May 25.—Inland Waterway Commissioner William A. Maupay announced today that preparations are completed for beginning work on the first section of the proposed extension of the inland waterway connecting Barnegat Bay with the Manasquan River. Sealed proposals for dredging this first section will be received by Mr. Maupay at his office in the State House until 12 o'clock noon, on Tuesday, June 15.

The section to be dredged begins at Barnegat Bay and extends northward three-quarters of a mile to what is known as the Township Board. The new waterway is to be made 100 feet wide and 6 feet deep, the same as the present waterway from Bay Head to Cape May. About \$20,000 is available for dredging this first section. The entire length of the extension to the Manasquan River will be a little more than two miles.
