The Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association has held its annual meeting and has outlined an extensive programme for the coming season. The Race Committee is expected to get down to actual schedule-making within a week or two. It is definitely announced that the regular summer series of races for the sneak box class will be resumed, and as well the annual championship catboat races for the Sewall Cup, and the Morgan Cup, will likewise be replaced on the season's schedule. The Seaside Park Yacht Club has taken no definite action, but it is generally understood that the club will again have its great powerboat race meet in with the Sewall Cup races held at that club on the second Saturday of August each year.

One of the features of yacht racing on Barnegat Bay each year are the women's races in sneak boxes. These women have become adepts at the handling of these sailboats, and have heretofore been a feature of the sport there. Last year most of these women became farmerettes, taking the place of men on farms, who had been taken into the service. These, too, will be back, and the old-time women's races will become a feature again.
