

BAYHEAD.

BAYHEAD, N. J., June 26.—Yachtsmen of high and low degree were on hand to-day and boats of all sizes and descriptions were entered in the initial regatta of the season on the schedule of the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association. The first of the 1920 races were sailed over the Bayhead course, and boats from Seaside Park, Mantoloking, Lavalette, Island Heights and other Barnegat Bay points participated in the event. During the morning the sneak box event for women was sailed, and this afternoon a big fleet got under way with the starting gun that started sailing activities for the men. Bayhead yachtsmen are bent on winning the Barnegat Bay honors again this year, and the local club boasts some of the fleetest craft in the bay area.

Tennis activities are again under the direction of Mayor Robert H. Metcalfe, who is completing the tournament schedule for the entire summer.

The yacht club is to be the scene of a revival of the bridge teas which proved so delightful in past seasons. A committee of women has been named to arrange for them and the social circles are awaiting the announcement of the opening date.

The summer camps on the shores of the Metedeconk River are to be opened early next month. The Princeton camp will be a lively place this year with the coming of several hundred boys for a long vacation period.
