J., July 31.—Having entertained the yachting enthusiasts of the Barnegat Bay Yacht Razing Association here last Saturday, the skippers of the Bayhead Yacht Club took their fast boats down to Seaside Park for the weekly regatta of the association which was sailed over the course of the Seaside Club. Some of the fastest boats in the Barnegat Bay waters claim Bayhead as their home waters and they are giving good account of themselves in the race for the bay honors this year.
