

Star Boats Seek Manhasset Trophy

Barnegatt Fleet Also Races Today Off Manto- loking Club Course.

MANTOLOKING, July 9—The local yacht club is host to the racing divisions of the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing association today while the members of the International Star fleet are competing at Seaside Park for the Manhasset trophy.

The association sailors are conducting races in the seven divisions which race weekly at one of the club courses on the bay. Sunday races tomorrow at Seaside Heights will include contests for star boats, class E sloops and class A catboats.

The Manhasset trophy for which the stars are competing is a perpetual trophy donated by the late H. Ross Turner of Seaside Park, one time proprietor of the Manhasset hotel which was destroyed by fire two years ago. Next week the Harvey Cedars and Little Egg Harbor Yacht clubs will make their annual cruise to the Island Heights Yacht club where they will participate in the weekly racing program. Special prizes are provided for these guests.

The races today give the Mantoloking club its only opportunity during the present season to act as host club to boats of the bay association.
