

Yachts to Race At Mantoloking

MANTOLOKING—The Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing association's 1941 program will open Saturday with the annual competition for the Chance trophy for E sloops at the Mantoloking Yacht club.

Commodore Philip R. Van Duyne, Newark, announced this week that two new trophies will be offered in this year's activities. The Crabbe trophy for Class A cat boats will be an incentive for sailors on the Seaside Park course in connection with the July 5 regatta at Lavallette. The other new trophy is the Van Duyne cup for comet class boats in the Bay Head event of July 26.

Skippers under 20 may enter the newly formed junior Comet class if they announce their intention at the beginning of the season. They may race either in the regular Comet events or in the junior class. Crew members can serve in both.

July 4: Island Heights Yacht club—Star class for O. F. Zurn III trophy.

July 5: Lavallette Yacht club—Admiral Elie La Vallette trophy for A sneaks; Yachtsman's club of Philadelphia trophy for B boats; ocean race at Ocean City.

July 12: Ocean Gate Yacht club—Dilworth trophy for Comets.

July 19: Island Heights—Wanamaker cup for E sloops and A cats.

July 26: Bay Head—Annual cruise of Little Egg Harbor Yacht club from Beach Haven to Bay Head; races at Bay Head Yacht club; second of ocean series off Bay Head.

Aug. 2: Toms River Yacht club—Toms River trophy for A cats; Doan cup for E sloops; Seaside Park—Annual Comet Atlantic Coast championships for Seaside Park perpetual trophy.

Aug. 9: Seaside Park Yacht club—Sewell cup for A cats; Wolstenholme cup for E sloops; Chance trophy for 17-foot catboats; Bamberger trophy for star boats.

Aug. 15: Annual cruise to Beach Haven from northern bay clubs.

Aug. 17: Island Heights—Morgan cup for A cats; Atkinson cup for E sloops; Turner cup for snipes.

Aug. 30: Mantoloking Yacht club—Bilgeboarders' trophy for E sloops; Island Heights—New Jersey Coast Star class challenge series.

Sept. 1: Seaside Park—regatta for E sloops, A cats and 17-foot cats.
