**LIGHTNING AND G SLOOPS—**

Spinnakers are permitted.

**"A" SNEAKBOXES—**

Sail to be not less than 4 oz. duck, 1 yd. @ 28½ ins. wide. - *Arear*  
Age for skipper and crew unlimited until restricted by competent authority.

**"B" SNEAKBOXES—**

Sail to be not less than 5½ oz. duck, 1 yd. @ 28½ ins. wide. - *Arear*  
Skipper and crew to be under 16 years on first race.

**JUNIOR COMETS—**

Skipper and crew to be under 20 years on first race.

**SENIOR COMETS—**

Skipper and crew any age, but skipper in this class cannot sail in any capacity in Junior Comets.

**LIGHTNINGS—**

Pgs. 32 & 33. Rule 30—Add all Lightning requirements. (By-laws & Racing Rules)

**RULES—**

Pg. 18, Rule 13, Sec. 3—Change ten (10) minutes to five (5) minutes. (By-laws & Racing Rules)
