

Dilworth Trophy to Sad Sam In Barnegat Bay Comet Sail

OCEAN GATE — Sam Fortenbaugh, sailing with his father as crew aboard the Sad Sam and representing the Bay Head Yacht Club, won the Dilworth Trophy for Senior Comets in the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association Regatta held here yesterday. Leonard Egee aboard Aelus was on Sad Sam's stern for most of the race and finished two seconds behind the winner. Don Sayia, in Stinger, was third.

Only two craft in the Catboat class were entered but failed to finish in their quest for the Beck Crabbe Memorial Trophy.

The Class E Sloops had no winner as two of the boats upset and the third sailed the wrong course.

In the Thistle class, Sam Merrick, who has been leading contender for honors in the class, broke his mast in the heavy squalls and the only other entry, Vim II won the race.

The largest field of the day was the Senior Comet class which saw eight craft cross the starting line. Heavy winds and rain kept a large majority of skippers from racing. The 17-foot Catboats and the Snipes had no entries.
