

Boat Skippers Repeat Wins

BEACHWOOD—Three skippers made it two in a row yesterday afternoon when they repeated last week's victories in sailing races sponsored by the Beachwood Yacht Club.

The winners were Fred Starcke, whose sneakbox, Skimmer took the Reindel Trophy; Mrs. Beth Olson, whose snipe, Babs won the Cornelius Cup, and Jim Cartledge, whose Comet Boomerange walked off with the schiller trophy.
