

Walker Wins International 14 Regatta

TOMS RIVER — Dr. Stuart H. Walker of the Annapolis Yacht Club sailed his craft "Salute" to victory in the International 14 Regatta here on Barnegat Bay yesterday.

He won three of the five races in the two-day regatta for 41½ points to win the Barnegat Bay Bowl, but missed out in the final race for the Toms River Trophy. This is a bit of spice added to the regatta three years ago. The final race in the series was stretched out to 26 miles for the Toms River Trophy. Dr. Walker finished fourth. He was second in the first race Saturday and won the middle three.

Moffett Wins Trophy

Jerry Moffett of New Brunswick, who was second overall with 39½ points, took the final race and the Toms River Trophy. Moffett, sailing "Dorade" won the first race also then finished 4-3-2.

Don Doyle, Essex Y.C., Conn., was third in the regatta with 36 points, coming in third in both races yesterday after finishing 4-2-2 Saturday. Behind him came Mark Caholon, Marblehead Frostdite Club, Mass., in "Andimo" who was fifth and second yesterday and 3-3-4 Saturday.

Other finishes were: R. C. Bartlett, Annapolis, Md., 23 points; Gordon Kempton, Toms River, 19; Tom Power, Annapolis, 18; Andrew Mutch, Annapolis, 12, and John Knight, Baltimore, 5.

Kempton recently acquired his craft and was racing it for the first time. It is the only International 14 on Barnegat Bay.
