## INSTRUCTIONS AND RACING RULES

The 1955 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of the B.B.Y.R.A. shall cover all races held under the jurisdiction of the Association unless otherwise specified. N.A.Y.R.U. Starting Signals will be used in lieu of Rule 8.

The Regatta Committee shall accept as a Corinthian a person who teaches small boat handling, sailing and yacht racing tactics in the performance of his duties as a director of junior activities during summer months and shall exclude a person, both as a skipper and crew, who accepts remuneration, directly or indirectly, for participating in a race or, who obtains a major portion of his or her livelihood by sailing or operating boats.

Any skipper withdrawing from a race without prompt notice to the Regatta Committee, or one of the Regatta Patrol Boats flying a numbered Patrol Flag, shall, upon notification by the B.B.Y.R.A. Regatta Committee to the Commodore or other representative of the skippers' Club, be disqualified for the next two races. The skipper, however, shall have the right to appeal within three (3) days to the B.B.Y.R.A. Regatta Committee, which Committee, should it affirm the disqualification, shall have the right to increase or decrease the penalty. The appellant shall have the right to continue to race pending decision by the Committee.

In order to qualify for Championship, a yacht must not be classified as a non-contender in either of the last two season races, or in more than two (Flying Dutchmen, Lightnings, Comets, Jets—five) races of those scheduled for her class, except that when a yacht represents the B.B.Y.R.A. or a member club fleet in a National Class race (or if she will qualify for Championship in both Jet and Jr. Jet classes or in both Comet and Jr. Comet classes) she may, at the discretion of the Regatta Committee of the B.B.Y.R.A., be granted one additional cut. This additional cut may be allowed in any of the season races.

Captains of National Class Association yachts are required to be members in good standing in their respective class organizations.

An entrance fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) shall be made for point races in Senior classes and a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) in Junior classes. Junior classes are: "A" Sneakboxes, "B" Sneakboxes, Junior Jets and Junior Comets. All others are senior classes.

Yachts intending to enter a protest must display a Protest Flag (Code Flag "B"). All protests must be submitted on the form provided by the Protest Committee.

### SPECIAL NOTICES

The B.B.Y.R.A. will select representative crews to compete for the North American Sailing Championship (Clifford D. Mallory Trophy), the North American Junior Sailing Championship (Sears Cup), and the Women's National Sailing Championship (Mrs. Charles Francis Adams Trophy), held under the sponsorship of the N.A.Y.R.U. Edwin J. O'Malley of the Mantoloking Yacht Club is Chairman of the committee representing the B.B.Y.R.A. for these events.

Finals will be held beginning on 24 August for the Adams Cup at Rye, N.Y., on 31 August for the Sears Cup at Noroton, Conn., and on 14 September for the Mallory Cup at Kemah, Texas.

The B.B.Y.R.A. will sponsor the Barnegat Bay Midget Championship for Juniors under 15 years which will be held at the Island Heights Yacht Club on August 14. Donald C. Horter, of the Island Heights Yacht Club, is Chairman of the Committee for this event.

The Lightning class will race in two divisions, the "B" division being for those desiring easier competition. The choice of division must be made when entering the first championship regatta in which the Lightning competes and can not be changed during the season. Each Lightning in "B" division must display her club burgee at the after stay.

Class "A" Sneakboxes must be sailed by a skipper and crew less than 20 years of age, must conform with class specifications, and sails may be of duck or nylon only. Boats built after 1952 must have measurement certificate.

Class "B" Sneakboxes must be sailed by a skipper and crew less than 16 years of age, must conform with class specifications, sails may be of duck or nylon only, and shall have a horizontal strip of black or red cloth, 12 inches long and 3 inches high, attached to both sides of the sail directly below the racing number. Boats built after 1952 must have measurement certificate.

Junior Comets and Junior Jets must be sailed by a skipper and crew less than 18 years of age.

Rooster Flags must be turned in before the next scheduled race or a deposit of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for its return will be required before entry will be accepted.

### PRIZES

Individual Place Pennants will be awarded for each regatta. A B.B.Y.R.A. Flag, similar to but smaller than the Championship Flag, will be awarded on the last race day to all yachts which qualify for the Championship competition by sailing in eight or more point races, including the last two races. All season Championship Flags and Trophies will be presented on the last day on the basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season.

Second place trophies will be awarded to Classes with from four to six qualified entries and third place trophies will be awarded to classes with more than six qualified entries in Championship Regattas.

The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (B.B.Y.R.A.) and the George R. Powell Trophy (S.P.Y.C.) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding accomplishment as provided in their deeds of gift.

The Pennock Trophy (S.A.Y.C.) for Class "G" Sloops will be presented on the last race day to the class champion.
