

The Spy takes regatta, trophy at Barnegat

Bob Sayia of Seaside Park, sailing The Spy, his class A Catboat, won the Beck Crabbee Memorial Trophy in the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing association's Ocean Gate regatta yesterday.

The race, yesterday's feature and an annual event, is started with the boats anchored and all sails furled. First vessel to reach Forked River, 14 miles from the Ocean Gate Yacht Club's starting line, wins.
