

BBYRA Cites Van Duyne At Age 79

BRICK TOWNSHIP — The Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association yesterday honored its oldest active official at a luncheon at the Shore Acres Yacht Clubhouse between the morning and afternoon races of the seventh championship regatta of the season.

The 79th birthday of past commodore Philip R. Van Duyne of the Bay Head club was celebrated and he was given a silver tankard carrying the BBYRA emblem and engraved for the occasion.

Before becoming BBYRA secretary to the association in 1932 Mr. Van Duyne had been a delegate from his club for five years. Later he became vice commodore and in 1941 was elected commodore. He was reelected in 1942. He has been a delegate from his club since that time.

The start of the morning race was delayed for an hour by a calm which changed to an easterly wind gradually rising to 15 knots for the afternoon races.

Peter DeCamp of the Mantoloking Club won the E Sloop race for the Alznauer Trophy.

Hansi Bonn, Lavallette club, won the Junior Jet race for the fourth time this season and was awarded the Tomlinson Trophy.

The Virkler Trophy for Senior Jets went to Frank Tubridy of the Beachwood club.

Bill Fortenbaugh of Bay Head won the G Sloop event for the Allsop trophy.
