## INSTRUCTIONS AND RACING RULES

The 1960 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of the B.B.Y.R.A. shall cover all races held under the jurisdiction of the Association unless otherwise specified.

Any skipper withdrawing from a race without prompt notice to the Regatta Committee, or one of the Regatta Patrol Boats flying a numbered Patrol Flag, shall, upon notification by the B.B.Y.R.A. Regatta Committee to the Commodore or other representative of the skippers' Club, be disqualified for the next two races. The skipper, however, shall have the right to appeal within three (3) days to the B.B.Y.R.A. Regatta Committee, which Committee, should it affirm the disqualification, shall have the right to increase or decrease the penalty. The appellant shall have the right to continue to race pending decision by the Committee.

In order to qualify for Championship, a yacht must not be classified as a non-contender in either of the last two season races, or in more than two (Flying Dutchman, Lightnings, Sr. Comets, Sr. Jets—three) races of those scheduled for her class, except that when a yacht or skipper represents the B.B.Y.R.A., or a Member Club's National Class Fleet in a National Class Championship Regatta or an elimination Regatta for qualification thereto, they may, at the discretion of the Regatta Committee of the B.B.Y.R.A., be granted one additional cut. This additional cut may be allowed in any of the season races.

Captains of National Class Association yachts are required to be members in good standing in their respective class organizations.

An entrance fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) shall be made for point races in Senior classes and a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) in Junior classes. Junior classes are: "A" Sneakboxes, Junior Penguins, "B" Sneakboxes, Junior Jets, Junior Comets and "M" Sloops. All others are senior classes.

Yachts intending to enter a protest must display a Protest Flag (Code Flag "B"). All protests must be submitted on the form provided by the Protest Committee.

### SPECIAL NOTICES

All yachts must carry safety equipment as specified by their Class or, in the absence of a Class rule, at least a paddle, bucket or pump, anchor and line, and one U.S.C.G. approved life preserver or a cushion for each member of the crew. All yachts are subject to inspection and disqualification.

**O'DAY CUP.** Finals to be sailed in Finns at Alameda Bay, California, July 19, 1963. Semi-Finals to be held by the Hudson River Yacht Association, June 29, 1963. B.B.Y.R.A. Eliminations to be held at Mantoloking Yacht Club on June 15th in Finns. Entries must reach Henry Tomlinson, Mantoloking, New Jersey by June 8, 1963. Contestants will be required to furnish their own Finn-Class boats.

**ADAMS CUP.** Finals to be held at the Manchester Yacht Club, Manchester, Mass. in 210's on August 26, 1963. Semi-Finals to be held by the North Jersey Yacht Racing Association at the Rumson Country Club in Arrows on August 6, 1963. B.B.Y.R.A. Eliminations to be held at the Shore Acres Yacht Club on July 24, 1963, in Lightnings. Entries must reach W. D. Donohue, 2295 Edgewood Terrace, Scotch Plains, New Jersey, by July 17, 1963.

**MALLORY CUP.** Finals to be held by the Chesapeake Bay Yacht Racing Association at Annapolis, Maryland, Monday, September 9, 1963, in Mobjacks. Semi-Finals to be held by the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association at Bay Head Yacht Club on August 17, 1963, in Lightnings. B.B.Y.R.A. Eliminations to be held at the Toms River Yacht Club on July 10, 1963 in Lightnings. All entries must reach Fredric Scammel, 105 Sassafras Drive, Island Heights, N. J., by July 3, 1963.

**SEARS CUP.** Finals to be sailed in Electra-Ensigns at Newport Beach, California, on August 26, 1963. Semi-Finals to be held by the South Jersey Yacht Racing Association late July in Lightnings. B.B.Y.R.A. Eliminations to be held at the Island Heights Yacht Club on July 17, 1963, in Lightnings. All entries must reach Donald C. Horter, 253 Harrison Avenue, Glenside, Pennsylvania, by July 10, 1963.

**MIDGETS.** Finals, Atlantic Coast plus Junior Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound and Eastern Connecticut to be held at Chesapeake Bay on August 26, 1963, in Cadets. B.B.Y.R.A. Championship to be held at the Seaside Park Yacht Club on August 9, 1963, in 12 foot Diamonds. All entries must reach Norman S. Brown, Capstan Avenue, Beachwood, New Jersey, by August 2, 1963.

**GENERAL INFORMATION.** One crew to a Club will be accepted in each of the above categories for the B.B.Y.R.A. Eliminations. H. Irving Dunn V/C, Chairman.

The Lightning Class will race in two divisions, the "B" division being for yachts weighing more than 775 pounds. Lightnings will sail in Class "A" unless certified eligible for Class "B" by the Class Measurer. Each Lightning in "B" division must display her club burgee at the after stay.

Class "A" Sneakboxes must be sailed by a skipper and crew less than 20 years of age, and must conform with class specifications. Boats built after 1952 must have measurement certificate.

Class "B" Sneakboxes must be sailed by a skipper and crew less than 16 years of age, must conform with class specifications, and shall have a horizontal strip of black or red cloth, 12 inches long and 3 inches high, attached to both sides of the sail directly below the racing number. Boats built after 1952 must have measurement certificate.

Junior Penguins, Junior Comets and Junior Jets must be sailed by a skipper and crew less than 18 years of age, and must display a pennant on the roach of the sail or end of boom at least 2 inches by 10 inches and of contrasting color except red.

Rooster Flags must be turned in before the next scheduled race or a deposit of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for its return will be required before entry will be accepted.

### PRIZES

Individual Place Pennants will be awarded for each regatta. A B.B.Y.R.A. Flag, similar to but smaller than the Championship Flag, will be awarded on the last day to all yachts which qualify for the Championship competition. All season Championship Flags and Trophies will be presented on the last day on the basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season.

Second place trophies will be awarded to Classes with from four to six qualified entries and third place trophies will be awarded to classes with more than six qualified entries in Championship Regattas.

The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (B.B.Y.R.A.) and the George R. Powell Trophy (S.P.Y.C.) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding accomplishment as provided in their deeds of gift.

The Pennock Trophy (S.A.Y.C.) for Class "G" Sloops will be presented on the last race day to the class champion.

The Chance Challenge Trophy will be presented as a season prize for the best final standing of an "E" Sloop ten years or older.
