Campbell Uses Borrowed Boat

LAVALLETTE — Joe Ellingham led a Toms River sweep in Junior Penguins and Cliff Campbell sailed Tom Reiser's M Sloop to victory yesterday to feature the morning session of Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association's ninth championship regatta.

A banner turnout of 27 competed in 16 classes at Lavallette Yacht Club in the next-to-the-last regatta of the season. The BBYRA closes out Saturday at Seaside Park Yacht Club.

Runyon Colie Jr., Mantoloking, was protested in winning the afternoon E Sloop race.

The fleet sailed in light 8-10-knot northeasterlies in the morning. The breezes shifted southeasterly at the same velocity in the afternoon.

Shallow water was a problem on the Lavallette course. The majority of the sailors couldn't even get their boards down.

Ellingham won his third race of the season in a 29-boat fleet of junior Penguins.

Campbell switched to the M Sloops to keep the absent Reiser in bay content and out-sailed a 37-boat fleet. Cliff won his victory on the reaches.

Bill Bonn, Lavallette, surprised the Beaton Sneakbox sailors by winning with a Perrine Sneakbox. Clubmate Gary Watson continued to win in A Sneakboxes.

Other class leaders winning in the morning were Bill Campbell, Beachwood, in intermediate Penguins and Jim Hahn, Bay Head, in Finns.

George Whittle Jr., Toms River, swept both the junior and senior Comet races. Whittle, a member of Shrewsbury's fleet, made a rare appearance on the bay.
