The recommendation was made that the "M" Sloops divide there fleets so that the competition is more equal.

The "E" Sloop fleet requested that the Lavallette Course be sailed in deeper water. There is too much shallow water on places in the existing course.

The "E" Sloop fleet also requested seasonal registration. This will be taken up at the Regatta Committee Meeting next spring.

Last year several Clubs were left with a large amount of food left over. This was due to the fact that a large fleet was away at a regatta. It is requested by the BBYRA Committee, that the Fleets notify the BBYRA, at the beginning of the season, of outside regattas, so that a mention of this can be made in the schedule.

There was discussion concerning the wearing of life jackets. It is a recommendation to the Regatta Committee that they consider requiring the wearing of life jackets at all times.

The Lightning fleet also took note of the shallow water on the starting line and at several turning marks. They also request a check of the depth of water prior to the start of a race.
