Report of the BBRYA Finance and Budget Committee: Frederic Winkelman, Ch.

It was unanimously agreed that the following two recommendations be presented to the Executive Committee for adoption.

1. In addition to the presently established \$19.00 annual dues, each constituent club shall be assessed a 25¢ surcharge per preceding year's paid membership.

2. Individual contributing memberships shall be established in the BBYRA with \$10.00 annual dues for seniors and \$5.00 annual dues for juniors (under and 18).

\*\* The motion was made to accept the recommendations, with the following changes: annual dues to be \$5.00, no age limit. Motion seconded. Motion carried.

For the purpose of assesment, it was the recommended that a -a-member—shall be one family unit, ie. wife, husband, \_ minor children.

\*\* This will require a new class of membership to the By-Laws. The new class will be knows as "Individual Contributing Membership at a fee of \$5.00, without voting privileges.

Discussion relating to the formation of a new "Standing Appeals Committee". This will also require a change in the By-Laws.

F. Thompson Brooks proposed the following revision to the BBYRA By-Laws.

Change first sentence of the second paragraph of No. 11,

Sec. 3, appearing on page 11 to read:

"Appeals from decisions of the Local Regatta Committee may be made to the Appeals (Sub-Committee) of the Association Regatta Committee. This (Sub-Committee) shall be appointed by the Commodore of the Association not later than March 1st of each year and shall consist of a Chariman and other members, each of whom shall represent a different member club. It's decisions shall be subject to review by the Association Regatta Committee and may be changed by a two-thirds vote of said committee".

The rest of the-second-paragraph-to-remain as is...

\*\* Motion made to accept the revision as presented with the recommendation that the Committee consists of a Chairman and four(4) members. Motion seconded. Motion carried.

A request was presented from both Bay Head Yacht Club and Metedeconk River Yacht Club, to provide a starting time for the Blue Jay Open Class during the P.M. races. The recommeddation is made to the Regatta Committee.

Having no further business, upon motion, meeting adjorned.
