INSTRUCTION AND RACING RULES

The 1970 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of the B.B.Y.R.A. shall cover all races held under the jurisdiction of the association unless otherwise specified.

BULLETIN BOARD — The Regatta Committee will maintain in the vicinity of the registration desk an official Bulletin Board upon which will be posted important information, announcements and notices of protests. Sailors should check it frequently.

SCORING — Scoring for the B.B.Y.R.A. Championship shall be in accordance with the 1970 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of B.B.Y.R.A. except that during this year "E" Sloops, Lightnings and Jets must be classified as a starter in at least nine races, and further that upon written request to the Official Scorer immediately after the finish of the last race, the skipper of an "E" Sloop who expects to qualify may have any one race (including the last race) eliminated from the championship record of his yacht. An eliminated race may be a DNS, DNF or DSQ.

MULTI-PENALTY SYSTEM — A Multi-Penalty System will be used for the scoring of all classes.

I. CLASSES OF PENALTIES

- A. A **TOTAL** penalty — disqualification shall be imposed for:
 - (1) infringement of Rule 49, Fair Sailing, or
 - (2) failure to sail course correctly, except touching a mark.
- B. A **MAJOR** penalty — the number of places equal to two-thirds of the yachts beaten to the nearest whole number but in no case less than one place, shall be imposed for the infringement of:
 - (1) the Opposite-Tack Rule 36, or
 - (2) all rules of Part IV before the infringing yacht starts.
- C. A **MINOR** penalty — the number of places equal to one-third of the yachts beaten to the nearest whole number but in no case less than one place, shall be imposed for infringements other than those covered in A and B.

INTERMEDIATE PENGUINS and "M" SLOOPS "B" DIVISION must display an orange pennant at least 2 inches by 10 inches on the roach of the sail or end of boom.

JUNIOR PENGUINS must display a green pennant at least 2 inches by 10 inches on the roach of the sail or end of boom.

An entrance fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) will be charged in each race of the Championship series for all classes except Junior Classes, in which case a fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) will be charged. Junior Classes are "B" Sneakboxes, Junior Penguins, Intermediate Penguins, and Junior Blue Jays.

ROOSTER FLAGS must be turned in before the next scheduled race or a deposit of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for its return will be required before entry will be accepted. Failure to return Rooster the second week will cause rejection of entry.

A **SPECIAL STUDENT CUT** will be considered for those students who are required to start classroom studies before the last race of the Championship series. The skipper or yacht may be granted the use of an unused cut for the last race of the Championship Series at the discretion of the Regatta Committee. Each request for action shall be in writing and shall include all pertinent details plus a copy of the School Schedule. The request must be received by the Chairman of the Regatta Committee at least eight days (8) prior to the date on which the cut is desired.

Properly performed entries for Regional Bay Eliminations for Sears and Midget Classes are to be forwarded or presented to the respective Chairman of the contestants' Region. Regatta Committee Representatives are reminded of the Delegates' action, "It will be the duty of each Club Representative to provide a yacht in racing condition of the class designated when he forwards his Club's entry in BBYRA Elimination races for National Cup Events."

2. Encourage your Club to qualify skippers for these competitions.

3. One crew to a Club will be accepted in each of the above categories for the BBYRA Eliminations.

PRIZES

All season championship flags and trophies will be presented on the last day on the basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season. A small B.B.Y.R.A. Flag similar to but smaller than the championship flag will be awarded to all qualifying yachts. Individual place pennants will be awarded for each regatta of the championship series.

First place individual regatta pennants will be awarded for each race of the championship series. Second place pennants will be awarded to yachts in each regatta when there are between 4 and 6 entries, and third place pennants awarded when there are more than 6 entries.

Season championship flags and trophies will be awarded to the winning yacht in each class. Second place trophies will be awarded when there are between 4 and 6 qualifiers, third place trophies will be awarded when there are between 7 and 17 qualifiers, fourth place trophies will be awarded when there are between 18 and 27 qualifiers and fifth place trophies will be awarded when there are more than 27 qualifiers.

The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (B.B.Y.R.A.) and the George R. Powell Trophy (S.P.Y.C.) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding accomplishment as provided in their deed of gift. The Chance Challenge Trophy may be presented to an "E" Sloop ten years or older with the best in final standing.

The B.B.Y.R.A. Past Commodore's Trophy will be presented to the member yacht club fostering the greatest participation in yacht racing on Barnegat Bay.
