Manasquan River winners were Wayne Patterson, Hobie 16's Jeff Connolly Jr., Jets and John Harkrader, Senior Penguins.

Four sailors retained their titles — Jim Carson, Metedeconk River, Lightnings; Cliff Campbell, Toms River, E Sloops; Patterson and Barry Connolly in the A Cat, Bat.

Carson practically 'owns' the Lightning tite having won it 16 times in the past 17 years. It was the third straight E Sloop crown for Campbell.
