Rear Commodore Roger Brown presided and opened the meeting by noting that the BBYRA plans course improvement by the appointment of a course committee who will be responsible for selection of appropriate courses with due regard to compass readings and the help of reports from patrol boats on remote parts of the course. A general discussion of course improvement followed.

There was general discussion of conditions under which races should be sailed or cancelled. Each class was asked what maximum wind velocity their craft could realistically negotiate in Bay races. The class representatives reported as follows:

18: Penguin, Sneak.  
20: Jet, Laser.  
25: "E", Scot, Lightning, "M"  
Indef: Hobie with double trapeze.

The group felt sea conditions should also be considered.

The Hobie representative requested their position in the starting sequence be changed to reflect their speed.

A request by the "E" sloop fleet for season registration met with no enthusiasm on the part of the BBYRA inasmuch as attempts in two past years had met with little success.

In answer to a question from the BBYRA the group unanimously felt lunches should be continued as they serve to promote fellowship and introduce sailors to one another.

Each Fleet representative was encouraged and agreed to support a program of assistance to qualifiers for national cup events. It was felt a list of available instructors should be drawn up with the assistance of the fleets so that knowledgeable persons might be available to assist participants who might be required to sail types of boats with which they are not familiar.

Each fleet was requested to file up-to-date class rules, restrictions, etc. with the BBYRA Measurer.

It was noted that the NAYRU Annual Meeting will be held at the New York Yacht Club on January 31, 1973 at 1600.

In answer to a question from Doug Love it was noted the BBYRA has a committee to bring the BBYRA rules into conformance with NAYRU.

Jim Carson noted that the BBYRA rules are contained in four documents - the "green book", the insert, the regatta schedule, and the course sheet. He felt these should be combined into one document of sailing instructions.

Doug Love suggested a representative aboard the committee boat might be assigned to follow the needs of each Fleet.

It was noted that the Bay would welcome a representative of each fleet at the Winter Meeting of the Regatta Committee. The Secretary will issue appropriate invitations.

Doug Love agreed to provide the Secretary with eligibility rules for the "A" and "B" Divisions of the "M" Fleet prior to the winter meeting.

Classes requesting extra races were advised to submit their requests prior to the winter meeting. Mike Heinrich noted that the Jets would like extra races on June 30 and July 14.

Suggestions from the fleet representatives regarding starting line administration included possible use of the line boat to recall premature starters and move the starting marker in case of radical wind shifts.

It was noted that sailors would be welcomed as guests aboard the committee boat.

It was noted that the low point scoring system would be used in 1973 but that details are not yet available.
