INSTRUCTION AND RACING RULES

The 1970 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of the B.B.Y.R.A., as amended, shall cover all races held under the jurisdiction of the association unless otherwise specified.

BULLETIN BOARD — The Regatta Committee will maintain in the vicinity of the registration BULLETIN BOARD — The Regatta Committee will maintain in the vicinity of the registration desk an official Bulletin Board upon which will be posted important information, announcements and notices of protests. Sailors should check it frequently.

SCORING — Scoring for the B.B.Y.R.A. Championship shall be in accordance with the 1970 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of B.B.Y.R.A. "E" Sloops and International "470's" must be classified as a starter in at least nine (9) of the twelve (12) races. Upon written request to the Official Scorer within forty-eight (48) hours after the finish of the next to the last race, the skipper of a yacht that expects to qualify may have any one race except the last one eliminated from the championship record of his yacht.

MULTI-PENALTY SYSTEM — A Multi-Penalty System will be used for the scoring of all classes.

1. CLASSES OF PENALTIES

A. A TOTAL penalty — disqualification shall be imposed for:

(1) infringement of Rule 49, Fair Sailing, or

(2) failure to sail course correctly, except touching a mark.

B. A MAJOR penalty — the number of places equal to two thirds of the yachts beaten to the nearest whole number but in no case less than one place, shall be imposed for the infringement of: the infringement of:

(1) the Opposite-Tack Rule 36, or
(2) all rules of Part IV before the infringing yacht starts.

C. A MINOR penalty — the number of places equal to one-third of the yachts beaten to the nearest whole number but in no case less than one place, shall be imposed for infringements other than those covered in A and B.

ENTRY FEES — An entrance fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) will be charged in each race of the Championship Series for all classes except Junior Classes, in which case a fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) will be charged. Junior Classes are "B" Sneakboxès, Junior Penguins, Intermediate Penguins and Junior Blue Jays.

"B" SNEAKBOXES must be sailed by skipper and crew under 18 years of age.

"M" SLOOPS will be divided by age. "A" Division 18 years and younger. "B" Division 19 years and older. Any skipper under 19 years may sail in the "B" Division if he/she so desires. LASER CLASS will be divided by weight. "A" Division 150 lbs. and under. "B" Division 150 lbs. and over. "A" and "B" Divisions will start together.

"B" CAT CLASS — 18-ft. Marshall Sanderling, 18-ft. Herreshoff America and 17-ft. Cape Cod. SAFETY EQUIPMENT — New safety requirements — One (1) wearable U. S. Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD), Type I, II, or III must be carried for each person aboard and MUST be readily accessible. All boats 16 feet in length or longer (except a canoe or kayak) must ALSO carry one (1) U. S. Coast Guard approved Type IV PFD (ring buoy or buoyant cushion) which MUST be immediately available.

ROOSTER FLAGS must be turned in before the next scheduled race or a deposit of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for its return will be required before entry will be accepted. Failure to return Rooster the second week will cause rejection of entry.

A. SPECIAL STUDENT CUT will be considered for those students who are required to start classroom studies before the last race of the Championship series. The skipper or yacht may be granted the use of an unused cut for the last race of the Championship Series at the discretion of the Regatta Committee. Each request for action shall be in writing and shall include all pertinent details plus a copy of the School Schedule. The request must be received by the Chairman of the Regatta the cut is desired.

PRIZES All season championship flags and trophies will be presented on the last day on the basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season. A small B.B.Y.R.A. Flag similar to but smaller than the championship flag will be awarded to all qualifying yachts. Individual place pennants will be

Second place pennants will be awarded to yachts in each regatta when there are between 4 and 6 entries, and third place pennants awarded where there are more than 6 entries.

Second place trophies will be awarded when there are between 4 and 6 qualifiers, third place trophies will be awarded when there are between 7 and 17 qualifiers, fourth place trophies will be awarded when there are between 18 and 27 qualifiers and fifth place trophies will be awarded then there are more than 27 qualifiers.

The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (B.B.Y.R.A.) and the George R. Powell Trophy (S.P.Y.C.) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding accomplishment as provided in their deed of gift. The Chance Challenge Trophy may be presented to an "E" Sloop ten years or older with the best in final standing.

The B.B.Y.R.A. Past Commodores Trophy will be presented to the member yacht club fostering the greatest participation in yacht racing on Barnegat Bay.
