Skippers MUST be Contributing Members of the B.B.Y.R.A. (Annual Dues MEMBERSHIP St. MEMBERSTHE — SKIPPETS MUST be Contributing Members of the B.B.Y.K.A. (Annual Dates \$5.00) by the third race in order to qualify their boat for Bay Championship points. It is expected that ALL skippers will be Contributing Members.

The 1970 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of the B.B.Y.R.A., as amended, shall cover all races held under the jurisdiction of the association unless otherwise specified.

SCORING — Scoring for the B.B.Y.R.A. Championship shall be in accordance with the 1970 Edition of the By-Laws and Racing Rules of B.B.Y.R.A., as amended. "E" Sloops, International "470's" and Lightnings must be classified as a starter in at least nine (9) of the twelve (12) races. Upon written request to the Official Scorer within forty-eight (48) hours after the finish of the next to the last race, the skipper of a yacht that expects to qualify may have any one race except the last one eliminated from the championship record of his yacht.

MULTI-PENALTY SYSTEM — A Multi-Penalty System will be used for the scoring of all classes.

(1) infringement of Rule 49, Fair Sailing, or
(2) failure to sail course correctly, except touching a mark.

ENTRY FEES — An entrance fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) will be charged for Lasers and Laser "M". One lunch will be supplied. A Four Dollar (\$4.00) fee will be charged for Sneakboxes, Penguins, Blue Jays, Hobie "16", Toronado, "B" Cats, "M" Sloops, and 470's. Two lunches will be supplied. A Five Dollar (\$5.00) fee will be charged for "E" Sloops, Lightnings, Thistles, and "A" Cats. Three lunches will be supplied.

When a class sails an Extra Pace the fee for the second race will be Two Dollars (\$9.00).

When a class sails an Extra Race the fee for the second race will be Two Dollars (\$2.00).

"B" SNEAKBOXES must be sailed by skipper and crew under 18 years of age.

"M" SLOOPS will be divided by age. "A" Division 18 years and younger. "B" Division 19 years and older. Any skipper under 19 years may sail in the "B" Division if he/she so desires.

"B" CAT CLASS — 18-ft. Marshall Sanderling, 18-ft. Herreshoff America and 17-ft. Cape Cod. SAFETY EQUIPMENT — New safety requirements — One (1) wearable U. S. Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD), Type I, II, or III must be carried for each person aboard and MUST be readily accessible. All boats 16 feet in length or longer must ALSO carry one (1) U. S. Coast Guard approved Type IV PFD (ring buoy or buoyant cushion) which MUST be immediately available.

ROOSTER FLAGS must be turned in before the next scheduled race or a deposit of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for its return will be required before entry will be accepted. Failure to return Rooster the second week will cause rejection of entry.

A SPECIAL STUDENT CUT will be considered for those students who are required to start classroom studies before the last race of the Championship series. The skipper or yacht may be granted the use of an unused cut for the last race of the Championship Series at the discretion of the Regatta Committee. Each request for action shall be in writing and shall include all pertinent details plus a copy of the School Schedule. The request must be received by the Chairman of the Regatta Committee at least eight (8) days prior to the date on which the cut is desired. the cut is desired.
