# **PRIZES**

All season championship flags and trophies will be presented on the last day on the basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season. A small B.B.Y.R.A. Flag similar to but smaller than the championship flag will be awarded to all qualifying yachts. Individual place pennants will be awarded for each regatta of the championship series. First place individual regatta pennants will be awarded for each race of the championship series, Second place pennants will be awarded to yachts in each regatta when there are between 4 and 6 entries, and third place pennants awarded where there are more than

6 entries.

Season championship flags and trophies will be awarded to the winning yacht in each class. Second place trophies will be awarded when there are between 4 and 6 qualifiers, third place trophies will be awarded when there are between 7 and 17 qualifiers, fourth place trophies will be awarded when there are between 18 and 27 qualifiers and fifth place trophies will be awarded when there are more than 27 qualifiers. The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (B.B.Y.R.A.) and the George R. Powell trophy (S.P.Y.C.) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding accomplishment as provided in their deed of gift. The Chance Challenge Trophy may be presented to an "E" Sloop ten years or older with the best final standing.

The B.B.Y.R.A. Past Commodores Trophy will be presented to the member yacht club-fostering the greatest participation in yacht racing on Barnegat Bay.

### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

MEMBERSHIP — Skippers MUST be Contributing Members of the B.B.Y.R.A. (Annual Dues—\$5.00) by the third race in order to qualify their boat for Bay Championship points.

ENTRY FEES — An entrance fee of Three Dollar (\$3.00) will be charged for Lasers and Laser "M". One lunch will be supplied. A Four Dollar (\$4.00) fee will be charged for Sneakboxes, Penguins, Blue Jays, Hobie "16", "B" Cats, "M" Sloops. Two Lunches will be supplied. A Five Dollar (\$5.00) fee will be charged for Lightnings, Thistles, and "A" Cats. Three lunches will be supplied. A Six Dollar (\$6.00) fee for "E" Sloops. Four lunches will be supplied. supplied.

When a class sails an Extra Race the fee for the second race will be Two Dollars (\$2.00).

"B" SNEAKBOXES must be sailed by skipper and crew under 18 years of age.

"M" SLOOPS will be divided by age. "A" Division 18 years and younger. "B" Division, 19 years and older. Any skipper under 19 may sail in the "B" Division if he/she so desires. LASER "M" 16 years and under.
