

Love sweeps E Scow races

MANTOLOKING — Doug Love, Bay Head Yacht Club, swept both E Scow scoring races yesterday as the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association met at the Mantoloking Yacht Club for the 75th season's third regatta.

It was the highlight of another busy day on the bay for a fleet of 257 in the morning and afternoon on the Green Island course off the Shore Acres section of Brick Township.

Winds were 12-14 knots from the southeast, but shifted southwest and lightened up by the end of the racing day.

Love's heroics in fleets of 20 and

26 of the 28-foot E Scows paced the Bay Head club to three victories, an honor they shared with the Pine Beach club. The other Bay Head winner was Bob Adams, in the 27-boat Sanderling catboat class.

Pine Beach winners were John O'Leary in junior Laser Radials, Paul Plump in Prindle 18's and Jon Kozzi in Laser 150's.

Metedeconk River, Ocean Gate, Seaside Park and Shore Acres each had two winners on a day when record fleets continued to turn out in what has been a banner season. BBYRA officials attribute part of the big turnouts to the various Laser classes, particularly the Laser Radial s. Yesterday there were 47 Radials racing.

The sailors were vying yesterday for a bevy of Mantoloking perpetual trophies.

Love took two of them — the O'Malley and the Bilgeboard. Mantoloking's Peter Wright won the Yachtsman's Cup in the open Laser Radial class, while O'Leary took the Carl III trophy in the junior Laser Radials.

Had Brick, Island Heights, won full-rig Lasers again and with it the Frelinghuysen trophy. He bested a 25-boat fleet this time and seems to be on his way to a seventh successive bay Laser championship.

Saul Janson, Ocean Gate, won the Laser II race and another O'Malley trophy.

the Sneakbox race for the David Beaton trophy. Bob Adams' victory in Sanderlings secured the William O. Price award.

Stuart Challoner, Metedeconk River, topped a 20-boat M Scow fleet for an O'Malley trophy.

Paul Beavis, Manasquan River, won the 20 boat Blue Jay race and Perry Connell, Seaside Park, took the Modified Laser race.

Shore Acres winners were Ralph Mance in Flying Scots and Mark Schleckser in Hobie 18's. Paul Gelenitis, Metedeconk River, won the Lightning race.

Frank Brady, Toms River, topped a seven-boat Ensign fleet.

All five A Cats raced for the first time and Nelson Hartranft's Wasp, Ocean Gate, was the winner over the

Bat and the Mary Ann. The Lotus and Spy finished fourth and fifth.

The BBYRA season shifts down-bay next Saturday as Toms River Y.C., hosts the season's fourth regatta. The historic Toms River Challenge Cup for the A Cats is the highlight. The Challenge Cup is the oldest trophy still sailed for on the bay. The Ensigns will also have two scoring races that day.
