PRIZES

Trophies listed above will be awarded at Regatta Headquarters at the conclusion of the morning and afternoon races.

All season championship flags and trophies will be presented on the last day on the basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season. A small B.B.Y.R.A. Flag similar to but smaller than the championship flag will be awarded to all qualifying yachts. Individual place pennants will be awarded for each regatta of the championship series. The B.B.Y.R.A., may suspend the awards for a class's season championship series if the final outcome of its series is dependent on the outcome of an appeal.

First place individual regatta pennants (a small rooster Flag) will be awarded for each race of the championship series. Second place pennants (red swallow-tailed pennant with host clubs' letters and year) will be awarded to yachts in each race of the championship series when there are at least 4 entries. Third place pennants (white swallow-tailed pennant with host clubs' letters and year) will be awarded in each race of the championship series when there are 7 or more entries.

Season championship flags and trophies will be awarded to the winning yacht in each class. Second place trophies will be awarded where there are at least 4 qualifiers, third place trophies will be awarded when there are at least 7 qualifiers, fourth place trophies will be awarded when there are at least 18 qualifiers, and fifth place trophies will be awarded when there are at least 28 qualifiers.

The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (B.B.Y.R.A.) and the George R. Powell Trophy (S.P.Y.C.) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding accomplishment as provided in their deed of gift. The Chance Challenge Trophy may be presented to an E Sloop ten years or older with the best final standing.

The B.B.Y.R.A. Past Commodores Trophy will be presented to the member yacht club fostering the greatest participation in yacht racing on Barnegat Bay.

The B.B.Y.R.A. Race Management Trophy may again be awarded as provided in its deed of gift.

Entries must reach William L. Campbell by July 3, 1989 and will not be accepted later. See address and telephone number at top of page.

 - One crew from a Club will be accepted in each of the above categories for the BBYRA Eliminations except O'Day, as to which there are no limits to the number of entries; Midget and Boardboat, in which two crews may participate.
 - Definition of Sex/Age Requirements:
JUNIORS - Boys and Girls who have reached their thirteenth but not their eighteenth birthday during the calendar year.
ADAMS - Females only - skipper and crew must be eighteen; one crew member may be fifteen.
MALLORY - Male skipper - females allowed for crew - must be eighteen or over.
O'DAY - Must have reached their sixteenth birthday same year as series.
PRINCE OF WALES - No restrictions on age or sex.
MIDGETS - Boys and Girls who have not reached their fifteenth birthday during the calendar year of series.
BOARD SAILORS - Same as JUNIORS.
