Minutes of the Regatta Committee Meeting 7/16/94

Location : Toms River Committee Boat

Meeting was called to order by Commodore Wedam. A Quorum of Member clubs was present.

The purpose of the meeting was to change two parts of the Sailing Instructions.

1) Crossing the start or finish line during the race:

It was proposed to amend the Sailing instructions to allow Yachts to test the finish line before the race. The present instructions prohibit that.

A motion was made by Vice Commodore Doria to change paragraph 9.5 as follows:

9.5 Yachts sailing on a leg of the course may not cross the start or finish line except to start or to finish.

The motion was seconded by C. Logan.

The motion was carried unanimously in favor.

2) Position of the finish line:

It was proposed to amend the Sailing Instructions to allow the pin marking one end of the finish line to be on either side of the committee boat. The present instructions define the pin to be on the port end of the finish line.

A motion was made by Vice Commodore Doria to change paragraph 11.2 as follows:

11.2 The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat and an orange cylinder with an "L" painted on the side.

The motion was seconded by H. Waite.

The motion was carried unanimously in favor.

Notice will be posted starting at the next regatta on July 23. Regatta committee representatives were asked to communicate the change to the sailors. Special hand-outs will be available at the registration desk.

The meeting was adjourned at 13:05

THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS ARE HEREWITH CHANGED AS FOLLOWS:

1) Crossing the start or finish line during the race:

The regatta Committee has decided to amend the Sailing instructions to allow Yachts to test the finish line before the race. The present instructions prohibit that.

**NEW TEXT:**

**9.5 Yachts sailing on a leg of the course may not cross the start or finish line except to start or to finish.**

2) Position of the finish line:

It was proposed to amend the Sailing Instructions to allow the pin marking one end of the finish line to be on either side of the committee boat. The present instructions define the pin to be on the port end of the finish line.

**NEW TEXT:**

**11.2 The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat and an orange cylinder with an "L" painted on the side.**
