Hangarter trophy, an award her older brother Jon, 20, who sails at Brown University, has won twice (1989-90).

"It was kind of yucky out there today," Zwarg said. "But I had a pretty big lead. I just kept thinking that I was going to lose it, but it picked up a little later in the afternoon."

Zwarg's been sailing Laser Radials for four years. Before that she made the logical transition of boats from an Optimus Pram to a Blue Jay and now up to a Laser. Jon was the BBYRA Laser Radial champion last year for the season, but Brooke doesn't see having a successful sibling as a drawback.

"He's more of a teacher than a foe," she said. "He sails Laser Full Rigs at Brown, so he really knows what he's doing."
