Delegates Meeting April 28, 2001 at 1330 Bay Head Yacht Club

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Commodore Harry Foote. Roll call was taken by Secretary Betty Jane France. All clubs were represented with the exception of Mantoloking Yacht Club. A motion was made, seconded, and passed to accept the minutes of the October 7, 2000 Delegates Meeting. Correspondence was received from Save Barnegat Bay, Pat Heacock, and Zoe Wells.

Other correspondence had been referred to the Regatta, Liaison, or Class Eligibility Committees.

OFFICER REPORTS:

Commodore -

Commodore Harry Foote reported that the Executive Committee had met. They reviewed and approved the 2001 Racing Rules. How class requests brought before the Liaison Committee have led to change was explained. They discussed the proposed schedule rotation which will be brought up again at the October meetings.

Vice Commodore -

Vice Commodore Patricia Applegate reported that the officers have met all winter finalizing schedules for individual classes and working on the rules.

The Regatta Committee met on 2/24/01 and approved the 2001 Racing Rules and Sailing Instructions which are on our web page. Our changes reflect changes made by US Sailing. Patti thanked Jim Carson and his committees for considerable effort.

Rear Commodore -

Rear Commodore Richard Sayers informed those present that the equipment is in order and the radios ready to go.

Fleet Captain -

Fleet Captain John Heacock announced that five to six hours of defibrillator training will be held on May 18 at Metedeconk River Yacht Club.

Measurer -

Measurer James Carson will send a letter to class representatives asking them to update their course requests and class documents.

Treasurer -

Treasurer Anne Attridge reported that all but two clubs have paid their \$200 annual dues. Four clubs have sent checks for individual memberships. Some clubs bill all members for BBYRA individual dues; all clubs are urged to adopt this policy. The checking account balance is \$12,005.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed to approve the Treasurer's report.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

BBYRA Representative to US Sailing -

P/C Roger Brown, our representative, reported that the spring meeting of USSA was held in Charlotte, NC March 22 - 25, 2001. His report was distributed to a Delegate from each club. The complete minutes are now on the web site of US Sailing.

Some highlights are -

The US Olympic Committee has a new President, Sandy Baldwin.

During the year 2000, over 3600 kids participated in 20 Jr. Olympic Festivals.

A new edition of "Join the Race Committee Team" is now in print.

The Sears Finals will be held this year at Metedeconk River yacht Club.

The requirement that both genders be represented on each Sears Team has been eliminated. A crew list will be published on the web.

Patti asked that our Sears Cup eliminations be separated from Bemis/Smythe eliminations.

Junior Sailing -

Chairwoman Evelyn Seymour distributed the 2001 Junior Sailing Coordinator List and the 2001 Junior Sailing Calendar which are current but subject to change. Evelyn will request that the Flying Scot Fleet use juniors as crew for one evening race this summer.

Membership -

Chairman Mike Corbett sent word that decals and membership cards have been distributed to the four clubs who have sent checks for individual memberships. Commodore Foote would like to have all cards and decals distributed to the clubs by the Commodores Ball on June 2.
