

#### BBYRA Junior Sailing Committee Report October 1, 2005

As Chair of the Junior Sailing Committee, I report to you the following:

- 1. The Junior Sailing Coordinators from each of the 13 BBYRA clubs met collectively in November of 2004, January, April, June and September of 2005. Host clubs were, TRYC, MCYC, MYC and OGYC.
- 2. Attended the US Sailing National Junior Sailing Symposium in Miami in January. Report on the symposium was submitted to the BBYRA at the April Delegates meeting.
- US Sailing Level I Instructor Certification was held over Memorial Day weekend, with OGYC serving as the host. Twenty-one candidates attended. OGYC provided housing for one Instructor Trainer and IHYC provided housing for the second.
- 4. American Red Cross Re-certification course was held in June with MYC serving as host.
- 5. Participated in the planning and implementation of the Dave Perry Seminars. Instructor Training Seminar was held on June 17, 2005 at Ocean County College. (Report on Dave Perry Seminars attached.)
- 6. US Coast Guard permits were obtained through six (6) summary applications: Upbay Interclubs, Downbay Interclubs, Upbay Regattas, Downbay Regattas, Upbay Sailing Programs and Downbay Sailing Programs. Original permits were provided to coordinators at the June Packet meeting. I also forwarded a copy of the applications to NJ State Marine Police for their files.
- 7. Postcards were mailed out to over 60 junior sailing programs outside of the BBYRA directing them to the BBYRA website to obtain NORs for BBYRA Junior Regattas in lieu of mailing out the NORs.
- 8. Packet meeting was held at MYC in June. Packets of each club's NOR as well as administrative BBYRA information were made that night and distributed to the 13 clubs. The packet meeting was immediately followed by the Ribcraft reception hosted by MYC where each club picked up their Ribcraft. A collective gift from the 13 clubs was presented to Peter Kellogg at that time.
- 9. Thank you notes have been sent to clubs that have hosted meetings and/or training sessions (including Ocean County College).
- 10. 2005 Junior Sailing Season Summary was compiled with data provided by each club's 2004 sailing program coordinator (2005 Summary attached). To briefly summarize 2004:
  - a. 899 junior sailors were enrolled in programs (an increase of 72 over 2004)
  - b. 87 instructors were employed by the 13 clubs (an increase of 4 over 2004);
     80 were certified at Level I and 6 at Level II (in 2004 all were certified);
  - 89 club owned patrol boats supported their programs (an increase of 7 over 2004)

- d. Nine interclubs were held in 2005, the same as 2004; 1,492 collective participants in 2005, an increase of 194 over 2004;
- e. 13 regattas were hosted by 11 clubs 1,974 participants in 2005, an increase of 428 over 2004;
- f. 9 clubs had junior sailors participate in the BBYRA series (an increase of 4 over 2004); 9 clubs had instructors participate in the BBYRA series (a decrease of one over 2004);
- g. Eleven clubs have sailing program coordinators in place for 2006 season; experience ranges from 9 years to 3 weeks; collectively there is 35.6 years experience amongst the coordinators in place.
- 11. Expense Summary for 2005: attached is a summary of how budgeted funds were expended for the 2005 season.
- 12. Proposed Budget for 2006: attached is a budget that was submitted to the BBYRA Officers on September 16, 2004 for their review and consideration to be included in the 2005 BBYRA budget. Funds are budgeted for training to improve the quality of sailing programs through instructor training and coordinator training.

Thank you to those who are consistently there to support junior sailing in many capacities: the BBYRA officers, my fellow committee chair, the junior sailing coordinators, and all the clubs. Your support, encouragement and commitment allowed almost 900 junior sailors experience a great summer of sailing experiences.
