

BBYRA Jr. Sailing Committee Report
10/4/08

As Chair of the Junior Sailing Committee, I report:

- The Jr Sailing Coordinators from the 13 BBYRA clubs met on November 16, 2007 at BHYC, March 14, 2008 at TRYC, June 16, 2008 at MYC, and September 26, 2008 at LYC.
- A representative of the group, George Francis from MCYC, attended the US Sailing National Sailing Program Symposium in St. Petersburg, FL 1/9-1/13/2008. His report was presented to the Jr. Coordinators and to the BBYRA at the April 2008 Delegates meeting.
- US Sailing Level 1 Certification course was held at MCYC over Memorial Day weekend 5/23-5/26/08. MCYC provided housing for the one Instructor Trainer. Approximately 15 students attended. All achieved certification.
- Red Cross CPR recertification was offered on June 16, 2008 at MYC with 25 students achieving recertification.
- Postcards were mailed out to regional junior sailing programs outside of the BBYRA instructing them to the BBYRA website to obtain NORs and registration information for BBYRA regattas.
- Packets of BBYRA NORs, registration forms, and additional BBYRA information were distributed to each of the 13 BBYRA clubs plus OCC at the June 16th packet meeting. Packets were also mailed to the Ocean Star and Asbury Park Press sports editors.
- Host clubs were secured for Sears/Bemis/Smythe BBYRA Eliminations (SPYC), Bemis/Smythe Area Cs (LYC), and BBYRA Midget Eliminations (BHYC).
- A very successful Coordinator Seminar was held in conjunction with the NJYRA (thanks to Jeff Jacobi) on April 5th at Raritan Yacht Club. The seminar leader was Kim Hapgood, Program Director of SailNewport.
- The 2008 Jr. Sailing Program Summary is attached. Some of the highlights are:
 - 926 junior sailors were enrolled in programs – an increase of 11
 - 98 instructors were employed by the 13 clubs – an increase of 2
The 98 instructors were supported by 92 club boats – a decrease of 3 boats
 - 95 instructors held Level 1 Certification and 8 held Level 2 – an increase from 90 and 5 respectively.
 - 9 interclubs were held – an increase of 1
 - 10 regattas were held – the same as in 2007 but with a participation of 2155+ representing an increase of 122+
 - Juniors from 8 clubs participated in the BBYRA – a decrease of 3 clubs
 - Instructors from 9 clubs participated in the BBYRA – a decrease of 2 clubs
 - All 13 clubs have coordinators in place for 2009, three will be new
- Attached are the 2008 Expense Summary, detailing expenses during the year, and the proposed 2009 Budget

- At our fall meeting at LYC on September 26th, we discussed issues that had arisen during the season, possible instructor or coordinator training, and began planning the 2009 calendar.
