Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association Executive Committee Meeting Minutes April 4, 2009 Bay Head Yacht Club

<u>**Call to Order**</u> – Commodore Robert Morrow called the Executive Committee meeting to order at 10:34 a.m. Commodore Morrow welcomed all and thanked BHYC for hosting today's meetings.

Roll Call – BBYRA Clubs represented: Bay Head Yacht Club, Island Heights Yacht Club, Lavallette Yacht Club, Manasquan River Yacht Club, Mantoloking Yacht Club, Metedeconk River Yacht Club, Normandy Beach Yacht club, Ocean County College, Pine Beach Yacht Club, Seaside Park Yacht Club; BBYRA clubs not represented: Beachwood Yacht Club, Ocean Gate Yacht Club, Shore Acres Yacht Club, Toms River Yacht Club. Also present were BBYRA Officers Commodore Robert Morrow, Vice Commodore Rich Proko, Rear Commodore Ed Reardon, Fleet Captain Bob King, Measurer Jim Carson, Treasurer James Maida, Secretary Sue Oksen-Pereira, P/C Bill Schever, P/C Jack Heacock, P/C T. Donald McNeil and P/C Dave Loughran. Final version of the 2009 contact sheet was Sue presented the 2009 Secretary's Award to Steve distributed to all. Foster/NBYC for being the first club to return their contact information. (A copy of the 2009 BBYRA Contact Listing - Revised March 9, 2009 is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein.)

Approval of Minutes –Since there were no changes to the October 2008 Minutes as posted on the BBYRA website, Commodore Morrow declared the minutes stand approved as written and posted.

<u>**Correspondence**</u> – Secretary Sue Oksen-Pereira reported the following correspondence has been received since the October 2008 meeting:

- 1. Correspondence from BHYC secretary RE: confirming BBYRA use of clubhouse for April 4, 2009 meeting venue;
- 2. Correspondence from NBYC commodore RE: authorizing Steve Foster to represent NBYC at all BBYRA meetings for the 2009 season;
- 3. Correspondence from the M Scow Fleet RE: fleet will give perpetual trophy to M Scow BBYRA champion at end of season;
- 4. E-mail from MCYC commodore RE: appointing Jody Lutz as MCYC executive rep; and
- 5. E-mail from MRYC commodore RE: authorizing Bill Scheyer and/or June Kingman to vote on behalf of MRYC for today's meeting(s).

Unfinished Business

1. Individual Dues/Yacht Club Dues – Treasurer James Maida reminded all that the fiscal year has been changed. Feirer Fund has approximately \$40,000 –\$80. was distributed in 2008 (only one applicant). Five Thousand was added to the fund to raise the principle – interest is 1.5%; anticipating 2009 distribution amount available to be \$600 per the deed of

gift. Regular checking account balance is approximately \$98,000; club invoices for 2009 were sent out on 3/1; BBYRA sent in \$10 for each member. Clubs are encouraged to send in \$10 per each individual member. Clubs that have individual BBYRA memberships of 90% or more will then have club BBYRA dues of \$25. First season registration was received today. Operating budget is approximately \$50,000 for the year. James is being very conservative with the funds – it is all in an FDIC insured checking account at Bank of America. After the banking industry settles down, the situation will be reviewed in September. The officers met last month – every effort is being made to be conservative with BBYRA funds.

- Second PM Racing Circle Vice Commodore Rich Proko reported that the Sailing Instructions Committee advised that a second racing was feasible and the Regatta Committee voted and approved a seconding racing circle on a one-year trial basis for the A-Cat and E-Sloop fleets on three downbay racing days (IHYC, TRYC, and BYC). The competing fleets will provide enough support.
- Dave Perry Seminar Fleet Captain Bob King advised that on June 19th, Dave Perry will do the same program that he did in 2005. Event will be held at OCC. Daytime program is for junior sailing instructors (9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.) with evening program for all sailors (7:30 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.). OCC will be sending out advertisement.
- 4. *Beachwood YC Regatta Day Leukemia Cup* General Program & Services Chair Bill Scheyer reported that per his discussion with the insurance company that for liability issues all on-the-water activities must be separate – after the race committee is done/off-duty, there are no issues. Sue Oksen-Pereira advised that BYC is not moving forward since the event could not be connected by title.
- 5. 2009 BBYRA Commodores' Ball Vice Commodore Proko advised that the event will be held on June 13, 2009 in the early evening. It will be a casual affair no uniforms; invitations will be going out in the near future. There will be no auctions. There will be some docking space available and taxi/valet services for those who will be driving.

New Business -

- 2010 Champion of BBYRA Champions Vice Commodore Proko advised that 2009 invitations were mailed out yesterday (SPYC will be host/fleet: sunfish). A host is needed for 2010. Roy Wilkins/OCC offered to host 2010 in collegiate 420's. OCC new building should be finished by then – if it's not, he will be going to another club to host the after party.
- 2011 BBYRA Commodores' Ball 2009 host is OGYC; 2010 host is MRYC. Host is needed for 2011. Other upcoming hosts: 2014 host is BHYC (BBYRA 100th Anniversary), 2016 host is PBYC (PBYC 100th Anniversary).
- 3. *Rededication of Perpetual Trophies* BBYRA perpetual trophies for US Sailing ladder events are awarded if BBYRA holds eliminations per BBYRA rules. Due to declining YRA eliminations, US Sailing is moving to

eliminate YRA eliminations and hold open area events. Bob is proposing for the delegates this afternoon that the BBYRA perpetual trophies for US Sailing ladder events be rededicated and the language be changed so that the perpetual trophy is awarded to the top BBYRA competitor in the Area C semifinal. There was no discussion. (A copy of the proposal is in the Commodore's Report, page 3, which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein.)

2009 Registration/Lunch Fees - Commodore Morrow advised that he will 4. be asking delegates to approve the fees as submitted in his proposal (Commodore's Report, page 5). All fleets are being encouraged to register for the season. Changes are necessary to the ensign fleet (number of races changed from 11 to 10; # of races difference change from +1 to 0; pre-season registration fee change from \$90 to 80; 2009 registration fee change from \$115 to \$110). After discussion it was decided to change the heading column "2009 Daily Registration Fee" to include "per race"; Sunfish (primary course) PRE-season registration fee change from \$65 to \$55; 2009 Registration fee from \$90 to \$80. Suggestions for consideration when deciding next year's fees: reduced fee for young sailors, first year participation in fleet; consider number of races x number of crew. (A copy of the proposal is in the Commodore's Report, page 5, which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein.)

Other Business

Judges Seminar: Fleet Captain Bob King advised that Chris Petracco will be holding a Judges Seminar on June 16 & 17 at MCYC. Ten participants are necessary for the course. Please share this information within your club.

Adjournment – Steve Foster motioned to adjourn the Executive Committee meeting, seconded by Jim Carson. Commodore Morrow adjourned the meeting at 11:40 a.m.

Proposed Change pending action by BBYRA Delegates Rededication of BBYRA Perpetual Trophies Awarded for USSAILING National Cup Events

History and Rationale:

In the past, our Perpetual Trophies were awarded to the winner of the BBYRA Elimination in ladder events for US SAILING National Championships. If there was only one registrant there was no Elimination and the lone sailor advanced directly to the Area C Semifinal and was to be awarded the BBYRA Championship Flag as the "BBYRA Representative" to the Area C event. If there was no BBYRA Elimination scheduled and more than one BBYRA sailor competed in the Area C Semifinal, the BBYRA Perpetual Trophies were awarded to the top BBYRA competitor at the Area C Semifinal *PROVIDED THE AREA C SEMIFINAL WAS SAILED ON BARNEGAT BAY.*

USSAILING is now moving toward an "open" Area Semifinal Event as the first step on the ladder of National Championship events. With this development we see the impending end of the YRA Elimination as we know it. This development is driven largely by the significant decline in participation at the YRA level of eliminations.

I am proposing for the Delegates' consideration:

- ...That BBYRA Perpetual Trophies be rededicated in the manner consistent with this change in how the ladder events are now to be competed.
- ...That BBYRA Perpetual Trophies be awarded to the top BBYRA competitor at the Area C Semifinal REGARDLESS of where it is sailed.
- ...That BBYRA Perpetual Trophies and the "BBYRA Representative" Championship Flag be awarded to the top BBYRA competitor at the Area C Semifinal Event.
- ...That these (rededicated) Perpetual Trophies and Championship Flag be awarded at the BBYRA Awards Ceremonies at the end of each season at SPYC
- ...That this proposed change take effect in 2009.

Proposed New Language

United States Sailing Association National Cup Events

4. TROPHIES – BBYRA Perpetual Trophies for US Sailing events will be awarded to the winner of the BBYRA Elimination when there are two or more entrants and an Elimination occurs. In the event that only one competitor enters the BBYRA Elimination and represents the BBYRA in the Area C Semifinal, the Championship Flag and Perpetual Trophy will be awarded. In the event that there is no BBYRA Elimination scheduled for a US Sailing event, and multiple BBYRA sailors compete in the Area C Semifinal, the BBYRA Perpetual Trophy and Championship Flag will be awarded to the top BBYRA competitor in the Area C Semifinal provided-the-Area C Final-is sailed on Barnegat-Bay.

Description: The BBYRA has a standing committee, the **Junior Sailing Committee**, to facilitate the training of juniors in and around Island Heights and to promote the advancement of sailing, sportsmanship, and safety among junior sailors on Barnegat Bay. The Junior Sailing Committee represents the BBYRA at US SAILING Junior activities, sponsors instructor training, assists with interclub regattas for juniors, provides race management equipment and training for those running regattas for juniors, coordinates the BBYRA and US Sailing Area "C" calendars in cooperation with the BBYRA chair of BBYRA sponsored US SAILING National Cup Events, e.g., Sears, Bernis/Smythe, etc, and develops programs for fund-raising activities by the committee in coordination with the Treasurer of the BBYRA.
