Delegates Meeting Minutes
April 10, 2010
Bay Head Yacht Club

Call to Order – Commodore Richard Proko called the Delegates meeting to order at 1:42 p.m. Commodore Proko welcomed all and thanked BHYC for hosting today's meetings.

Roll Call – Representatives for all BBYRA clubs were present. Also present were BBYRA Officers Commodore Richard Proko, Vice Commodore Ed Reardon, Rear Commodore Bob King, Measurer Jim Carson, Treasurer James Maida, Secretary Jennifer Alldian, P/C Bill Scheyer, P/C Jack Heacock, P/C Harry Foote, P/C David Loughran, P/C Bob Morrow, Junior Sailing Chair Susan Proko, Sailing Instructions Committee Chair Rich Kerdock, Membership Chair Eve Allison, Yearbook Chair Lorraine Morrow, US Sailing National Sailing Events Chair Jim Walsh, and Appeals Chair Chris Petracco.

Approval of Minutes – Since there were no changes to the October 2009 Minutes, Commodore Proko asked for a motion to approve the minutes which was made by Steve Foster, and seconded by Bill Scheyer. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Correspondence – Secretary Jennifer Alldian reported the following correspondence has been received since the October 2009 meeting:

1. Correspondence from Appeals Chair Chris Petracco RE: resigning his position effective today April 10, 2010. Commodore Proko thanked him for his years of service on the Appeals Committee. Discussion followed on his new position. Commodore Proko reported that the other three members of the Committee have given their input on a replacement. Commodore Proko stated that a Chair has not been appointed yet, but that he is confident that the position would be filled.

OFFICERS' REPORTS:

Commodore – Commodore Richard Proko distributed copies of his written report (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein). Would like to thank everyone who serves on the committee and who goes out on the water every Saturday. He would also like to thank the families. All appointments have been made for the 2010 season. P/C Bob Morrow has been appointed

Chair of the Nominating Committee. Discussion followed on the 2011 US Sailing Junior Championships finals being hosted at TRYC. MYC and BHYC will host the 2011 Ida Lewis. Island Heights Sailing Foundation Grant application for junior sailing expenses has been submitted. Discussion followed on the motion for a Roberta Scheyer Trophy and the request of the family not to have another trophy in her memory. Number of Alternate representatives to Regatta Committee for 2010 is stipulated to be four (BBYRA By-Laws Article Eleven-Committees, Paragraph Seven).

Vice Commodore – Vice Commodore Ed Reardon reported that all committees are actively involved in planning and implementation of 2010 season. He especially would like to thank Rich Kerdock Chair Sailing Instructions and Ed Vienkowski Chair Class Eligibility. A second racing circle for the A-Cats and E-Scows has been approved for the LYC racing day. VC Reardon also made a plea for support on Saturday. There is a need for new people and cross training. People don't need to come out every weekend, maybe one or two or three weekends.

Rear Commodore – Rear Commodore Bob King reported that his job was to assist Vice Commodore Ed Reardon. Mainly to see that the trailer was at the host Yacht Club each weekend and that all the equipment is working properly. A new yellow tetrahedron mark was acquired to replace the old worn out one. Thank you to P/C William Scheyer and Stan Switlik (Switlik Survival Products donated the mark). Also new waterproof patrol bags were purchased to replace the old green bags.

Fleet Captain – Fleet Captain June Kingman was not able to attend so she provided a report to Commodore Proko. Commodore Proko advised that on May 1, LYC will host a CPR and defibulator training class starting at 10 A.M. On May 22 – 23, LYC will host a judge's seminar. Try to encourage every yacht club to send someone. There will be no U.S. Sailing patrol training seminar. This is still in the developmental stage. There will be a junior instructor training double session Memorial Day Weekend (May 28 – 31) at OGYC. Thank you to P/C Harry Foote for hosting both Instructor Trainers. There are currently three spots open. There is a clinic provided by Kim Hapgood which is sponsored by the NJYRA and the BBYRA on April 17 – 18 at Monmouth Boat Club for Sailing Directors. All Junior Coordinators are encouraged to attend.

Measurer - Measurer Jim Carson reported that we are well positioned for 2010. All classes have adequate information on their

web site with the exception of the A-Cats who have no rules. He has advised all the classes to notify him if there are any changes. Starting in 2011 all changes must be noted in the sailing instructions. (A copy of the Measurers Report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein.)

Treasurer – Tax returns were filled properly and on time. There is approximately \$100,000 in the checking account and \$40,000 in the Feirer Fund. Clubs are encouraged to send in \$10 per each individual member. Clubs that have individual BBYRA memberships of 90% or more will then have club BBYRA dues of \$25. Registration fees do not cover all of the race management expenses – balance (85%) is subsidized by club dues and individual memberships. Lunch reimbursements for 2010 will remain at \$5.00 (but will be watched and adjusted if revenue is exceeding expenses) and will be mailed out in August. Discussion on how the small clubs are not co-hosting followed. Officers are making every effort to be prudent with BBYRA funds and expenditures. Decals were ordered early this year. Lorraine Morrow, co-Chair Yearbook Committee is handling the promotion and collection of ads for this year's yearbook, which is revenue neutral.

Standing Committee Reports

Executive Committee - Commodore Proko reported that the following topics were discussed at this morning's Executive Committee session: 1. 2010 Champion of BBYRA Champions; 2. 2010 BBYRA Calendar; and 3. 2010 Registration/Lunch Fees. Discussion followed on George Scheyer's son Stan who is making an ocean trip.

Appeals Committee – Chair Chris Petracco, who resigned effective at the conclusion of this meeting to take a position at U. S. Sailing, gave his last report as Chair. There are no outstanding appeals. The average appeal around the country is 8 – 12 months and 50% go on to the national level. Discussion followed on Race Management for anyone under 35.

Protest – Chair Tom Sollas submitted a report to Commodore Proko that there was nothing to report since the October meeting . He has commitments from his committee to serve another year.

Scoring Committee - P/C Jack Heacock advised there was no changes for scoring to report since the October meeting.. Registration will start shortly. There is a discount if registered by

June 11, 2010. Discussion followed on how people are notified to register; email, paper copy, website or face book.

Junior Sailing Committee – Chair Susan Proko reported that the committee met in September 2009, November 2009 and February 2010. Next meeting is scheduled for June 14, 2010 for the “packet meeting” which will be followed by the CPR recertification course for the instructors at MYC; US Sailing Level I course scheduled for Memorial Day weekend at OGYC; opti “Green” language was approved by the Junior Sailing Coordinators on December 15, 2009 and is posted on the BBYRA website; permits have all been filled with the U.S. Coast Guard; Yacht Clubs have to submit their own permits to the U.S. Coast Guard and Marine Police for their regattas and interclub’s; BBYRA website will continue to be used for posting of BBYRA junior club events NORs; all regatta information should be to Jack Heacock by June 1, 2010; junior sailing programs will be starting on June 28th with the exception of MCYC which will start on June 23rd. BBYRA Midget eliminations will be held on 7/13; down bay interclubs will be run as a series again.

Membership Committee - Chair Eve Allison was unable to attend.

Sailing Instructions Committee – Chair Rich Kerdock reported that the SI committee responded to the feedback of the fleets, regatta committee and judges. The 2010 Weekly Class Schedule, RC Guidelines, and Sailing Instructions are final. Focus of the committee was to simplify everything. New for 2010: 1) Second PM Circle Up Bay for the A’s and E’s on LYC Bay Day (this will be done on an experimental basis for the 2010 season); 2) Signal changes on the Start Boat; 3) Class Flags on Finish Boats; 4) Finish Line position; 5) General recall procedure; 6) TLE included in the SI’s and 7) weekly flag requirement. (A copy of the Sailing Instructions Committee report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein.)

A motion was made to change BBYRA Regulations F5 (see Commodore Report Page 3) to read “registrants” instead of “starters”. Commodore Proko said that this proposed change would take effect for the 2010 season. Commodore Proko asked for a motion to approve the change which was made by Jack Heacock, and seconded by Steve Foster. Motion passed, only opposed Mitch Shivers, BHYC.

Eligibility Committee – Chair Ed Vienckowski submitted no report.

Laser Radial would still be retained and would sail with the full rig lasers. The junior sunfish will be a full fleet in 2010 as opposed to a provisional fleet.

US Sailing– Chair P/C Harry Foote reported US Sailing is in good shape financially. There will be a college membership offered that is good for four years and costs \$95. A high school membership will be offered soon.

General Programs & Services –

Insurance: Chair/PC Morrow reported that there were no claims filed and coverage has been renewed. Discussion followed on whether to continue inspections or do away with them. It was thought that inspections should continue due to the insurance coverage. The agent's opinion and the language that appears now, our first line of defense should be to stay as we are. There should be preprinted protest forms for failures.

Yearbook: Co-editor Lorraine Morrow reported that the book is coming along. Steve Foster has brought in a lot of ads. The book is break even.

Website: Webmaster/PC Heacock reported that there has been a moderate amount of activity. There has been a lot of updating on the website. July is the busiest month. "What's Up Coming", was started last year and continues to be used. Club's can access this site also to add/modify their open events.

Public Relations/Communications: Chair Dave Ruiter – absent/no report.

US National Cup Events – Chair Jim Walsh reports that he has given us a list of all the US Championships. US Junior events will be hosted later in the season. Women's championship will be sailed in Radials and the Men's Championship will be sailed in Full Rigs. The Mallory and Adams Cups have been combined and held at the same event.

Historical Committee – P/C Jack Heacock advised that things are quiet. He continues to archive items at the Toms River Seaport Society.

Unfinished Business

1. *2010 Championship of BBYRA Champions* – Vice Commodore Reardon advised that 2010 invitations to eligible competitors were mailed out last month. BHYC will host the regatta on Friday, June 18, 2010 and OCC will run the regatta. The

regatta will be sailed in Sandpipers. There will be a party and awards at BHYC following the races. They anticipate sailing five races and there will be boat exchanges as per the Championship of Champions Regulations. The Notice of Race is on the web-site.

2. *BBYRA Commodores' Ball* – Manasquan River YC will be the host. There will be email invites. The cost will be \$65 per person.

New Business

1. *2011 BBYRA Commodores' Ball* – Commodore Proko announced that BBYRA will accept MCYC's bid to host the 2011 BBYRA Commodore's Ball. In review the following is a list of future venues for the BBYRA Commodores' Ball:
 - 2011 MCYC – their 75th
 - 2012 MYC will propose to their Bridge/Board to host
 - 2013 SPYC
 - 2014 BHYC – BBYRA 100th
 - 2015 SAYC – their 75th
 - 2016 PBYC – their 100th
2. *2010 – 2011 BBYRA Calendar* – Commodore Proko referred all to his report, page 4 (a copy of the Commodore's Report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein.) Steve Foster motioned to accept the calendar as is, seconded by P/C Bill Scheyer. Motion passed by unanimous consent.
3. *2010 Registration/Lunch fees* – Commodore Proko referred all to his report, page 5 (a copy of the Commodore's Report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein). Registration fees remained the same except for Full Rig Laser. Full Rig Laser was raised \$10 since they have an additional four races. Radial Laser remained the same though they also have an additional four races, but this is a junior fleet and they are encouraging participation. Proposed change to the 4th column to be "2010 Registration Fee Per Race Schedule". Steve Foster motioned to accept the 2010 Registration Fees as proposed, seconded by Mitch Shivers. Motion passed by unanimous consent. Lunch fee will be held at \$5.00, for reimbursement and purchase.

Other Business

1. Discussion on getting the 420 more active in 2011. It was suggested that there be more up bay races.
2. March 19-20, 2011 in Chicago will be a club level meeting. Ted Turner will be the keynote speaker. Four representatives from clubs may attend.
3. Art Bailey notified the BBYRA the E Sloop class would like to donate a trophy for the E-Sloop AM class Champion to be presented at Seaside Park Yacht Club. A deed of gift will be prepared for the trophy.

Adjournment - With no other business to come before the Delegates, Commodore Proko asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. A motion was made by Steve Foster and seconded by P/C Bob Morrow. The meeting was adjourned at 3:59 p.m.

I would like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to the many members of our various committees and constituent yacht clubs who have given their time and talents throughout the fall and winter months helping to prepare for the 2010 sailing and racing season. I also want to extend my gratitude to the families of those mentioned above for their continued understanding and support of those so dedicated to our organization.

ACTIVITY REPORT

The following is a partial list of the Commodore's activity since the Annual Meeting on October 3, 2009:

- Appointed Chairs of Standing Committees for 2010. Chairperson changes included P/C Robert T. Morrow appointed as Chair, General Programs & Services and Susan A. Proko agreed to chair the Junior Sailing Committee.
- Consulted with webmaster P/C Jack Heacock to publish minutes of the Annual Meeting (10/3/09) to the website.
- Late January through early March, actively assisted P/C Robert T. Morrow (US SAILING / Chubb U.S. Junior Championships Area C Representative) and Susan A. Proko (Chair, Junior Sailing Committee) in campaigning to BBYRA Active Member clubs to submit a bid to host 2011 Chubb Junior National Championships. I understand TRYC was planning to submit a bid to host the championships in 2011.
- Submitted 2010 grant application to Island Heights Sailing Foundation with supporting documentation. Application asks for full funding of Junior Sailing budget (See attached pages 6 & 7).
- Called and held an Officers' Meeting on 3/20/2010.
- Finance Committee Meeting held on 3/20/2010 to address financial matters and review budget conditions.
- Received email resignation from Chris Petracco as Chair, Appeals Committee. Chris has accepted a position within US Sailing which will require that he step down from the BBYRA Appeals Committee. Traded communications with remaining Appeals Committee members regarding potential candidates to replace Chris on the committee.
- Drafted Proposed 2010 / 2011 Calendar (See attached page 4).
- Drafted 2010 Registration Fees (see attached page 5).
- Liaised with Art Bailey on E-Sloop donation of new perpetual trophy to honor long-time E-Sloop sailor. To be awarded to AM E-Sloop Class Champion. (See attached page 8).

- Liaised with P/C Robert T. Morrow regarding perpetual trophy in honor of Roberta Schreyer. Schreyer family is opposed to having another trophy created in honor of Roberta.

Proposed Change pending action by BBYRA Delegates
Proposed Change to the Regulations of the BBYRA

The Sailing Committee recommended the Regulations of the BBYRA be modified to award flags relative to the number of registrants not starters. The changes was proposed at the February 20, 2010 Regatta Committee Meeting held at TRYC. The Regatta Committee approved the proposed change to the Regulations of the BBYRA and subsequently recommended submission to the Delegates for final approval of the change. Therefore, I am proposing for the Delegates' consideration:

- That the Regulations of the BBYRA be modified to award flags relative to the number of registrants not starters, and
- That Item F.5 under Administrative Rules of the Regulations of the BBYRA be replaced in its entirety with the Proposed New Language below (color added for highlighting purposes only), and,
- That the BBYRA Scorer, be instructed to award individual pennants in accordance with the Proposed New Language, and,
- That this proposed change take effect immediately upon approval by the Delegates and becomes effective for the 2010 BBYRA Championship Series.

Current Language

F. ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

5. **First place individual regatta pennants will be awarded for each race. Second place pennants will be awarded when there are at least four registered boats and third place when there are at least seven registered boats.** *starters*

- 5/6.* **First place individual regatta pennants will be awarded for each race. Second place pennants will be awarded when there are at least four registered boats and third place when there are at least seven registered boats.**

Description: The BBYRA has a standing committee, the **Junior Sailing Committee**, to facilitate the training of juniors in and around Island Heights and to promote the advancement of sailing, sportsmanship, and safety among junior sailors on Barnegat Bay. The Junior Sailing Committee represents the BBYRA at US SAILING Junior activities, sponsors instructor training, assists with interclub regattas for juniors, provides race management equipment and training for those running regattas for juniors, coordinates the BBYRA and US Sailing Area "C" calendars in cooperation with the BBYRA chair of BBYRA sponsored US SAILING National Cup Events, e.g., Sears, Bemis/Smythe, etc, and develops programs for fund-raising activities by the committee in coordination with the Treasurer of the BBYRA.

Explanation of how request furthers the purpose of IHSF: The BBYRA is a non-profit organization founded exclusively to foster amateur sailboat racing competition across Barnegat Bay including the Island Heights area, on a national and international level, and to support and develop amateur athletes for the sport of sailboat racing. Many residents of Island Heights started their sailing careers through BBYRA and our junior programs. BBYRA provides training for skippers and their crews by organizing and/or holding competitive events and conducting classes and seminars. Throughout its history the BBYRA has produced many talented sailors at all levels, nationally, internationally, and indeed even at the Olympic level. In keeping with that history, its horizons continue to expand so that men and women of all ages can look forward to exciting sailing opportunities. BBYRA maintains the Edward W. Feirer Memorial Fund (Feirer Fund) created by the family of Ed Feirer, who, himself, was active in the BBYRA for many years. The purpose of the Feirer Fund is to help enable skippers "to pursue further competition beyond the BBYRA level" in US Sailing National Cup Events or US Olympic Qualification Events. A grant from the Island Heights Foundation will assist the BBYRA in upholding its long standing goals and traditions of promoting recreational sailing on Barnegat Bay, continuing to introduce children from Island Heights and the surrounding area to the sport of sailing and continuing to advance the skills of local children who are already avid sailors.

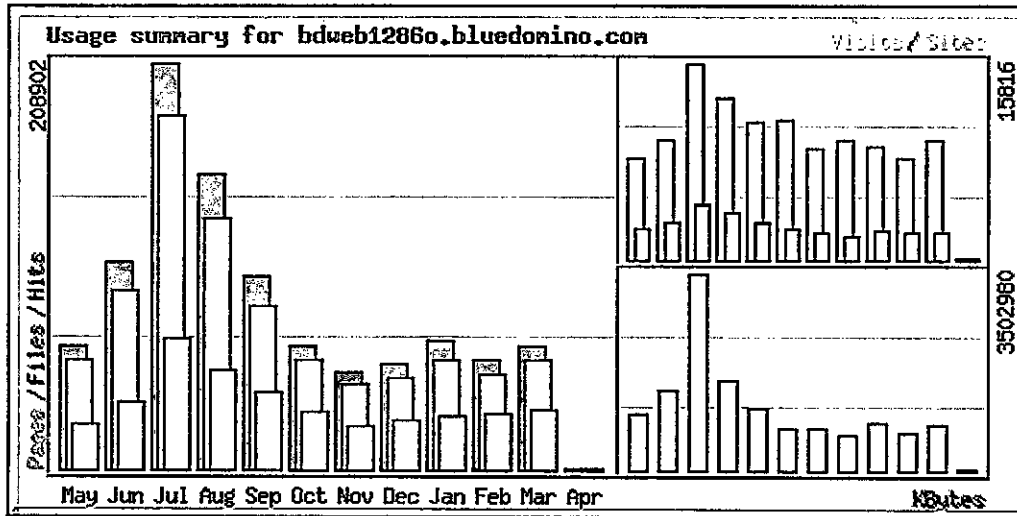

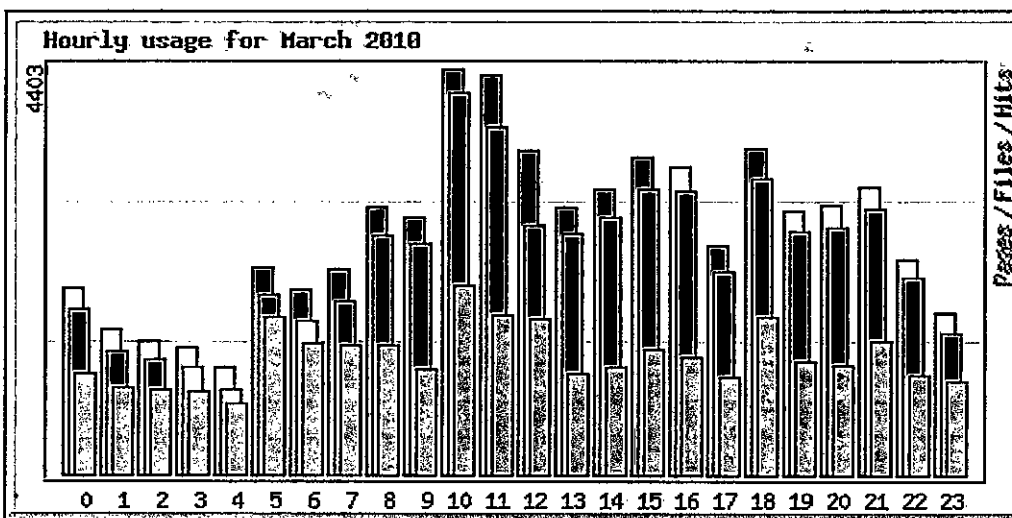
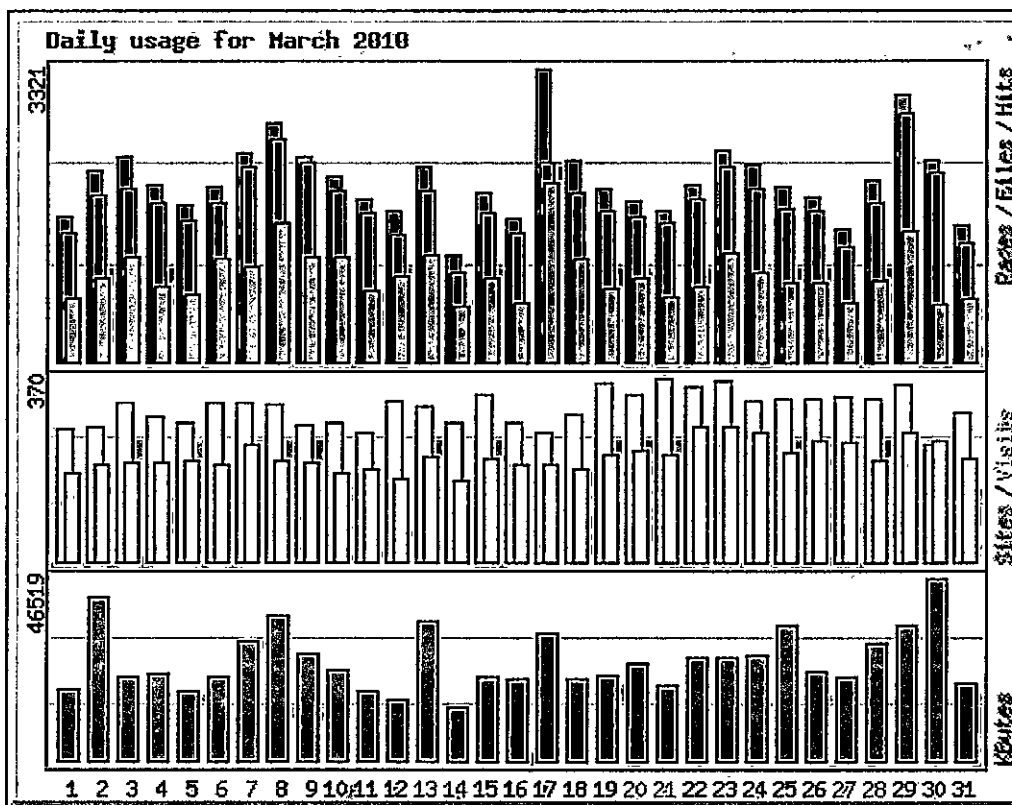
