Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association Liaison I Committee Meeting Minutes November 20, 2010 Metedeconk River Yacht Club

<u>Call to Order</u> – Rear Commodore Bob King called the Liaison I Committee meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. He thanked MCYC for hosting today's meeting.

Roll Call – All classes were present except Lightning and Laser Radial (absent). Also present: BBYRA flag officers Commodore Rich Proko, Rear Commodore Bob King and Fleet Captain June Kingman (Vice Commodore Ed Reardon, and Treasurer Jim Maida absent), and Secretary Jennifer Alldian (Measurer Jim Carson absent) as well as Class Eligibility Chair, and Sailing Instructions Committee Chair and members of various committees.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> - June Kingman motioned to approve the Liaison Committee II minutes of February 20, 2010, seconded by Allan Terhune. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

### Fleet Reports

**A-Cat** — Chip Hillyer had the following report:

- Fleet would like to continue to race one weekend at LYC and one weekend at SPYC with a second circle. At LYC they would like the Hankins course.
- ➤ Fleet would like the wind speed to be changed to sustained 20 knots no race begins, races shortened at 22 knots, and races abandoned at 25 knots
- > Fleet would like to have one drop for every five races
- ➤ Safety is a big issue so they would like a second set of gates. Short gates for the A-Cats and longer gates for the E-Scows.
- No barrels, windward/leeward only.
- > They would like the race distance to be 7-9 miles for a single race and 4-5 miles when there are two races scheduled.
- > Fleet would like to continue with the anchor start
- > Fleet would like their race schedule to be the same as last year
- > Flags for laps
- > They would like the time and speed to continue to be taken at the finish
- ➤ Discussion about how the A-Cat support boats and spectator fleet gets in the way of other classes sailing.

## **Ensign** — Allan Terhune had the following report:

- > Fleet is happy with last year. When they have two races in the afternoon, sometimes they feel that they are getting squeezed out.
- > They will be sailing four more races in 2011.
- > Fleet would like to be moved up in the sailing sequence to start earlier
- > Fleet would like some barrel courses, tired of only windward/leeward's.
- > Suggestion made to maybe start the afternoon races earlier.
- > See attached schedule request

# **E-Sloop** – Dave Magno had the following report:

- > Fleet liked the second race circle on the Seaside course and the Green Island course (on LYC day).
- > Fleet had issues with water depth sometimes
- > See attached schedule request

## **<u>Flying Scot</u>** – Rich Kerdock had the following report:

- > Fleet would like two races every weekend with one bye week at OG
- > Fleet would like barrel courses
- ➤ What is troublesome for the fleet is that it is shrinking, the big boats (A-Cats and E-Scows) are taking the crew

## Laser - Had Brick had the following report:

- > Not sure which weeks are needed off
- > Discussion on where the boats are anchored off Hankins house. Boats should anchor east of the barrel.
- Discussion followed on the equipment check. Not all boats were checked.
- > See attached schedule request

## **Laser Radial** – No representative and No Report

## **<u>Lightning</u>** – Jim Carson sent the following report in:

- > Fleet would like to sail in 2011. They have had meetings and emails and should have 3 clubs and 7 sailors next year.
- > Discussion in moving their starting spot. Other clubs are making strides to have more boats.
- ➤ Discussion on including LBI (with possible 17 boats) in three weeks of sailing.
- > See attached schedule request

# **M-Sloop** – Susan Kerr had the following report:

- > Fleet would like to use short leeward marks
- Fleet would like to shorten races 1 or 2, have shorter courses so that they can get back off the water before the afternoon races start.
- > Fleet is divided on barrels and windward/leeward courses; maybe one race each day should be a barrel or a triangle
- > See attached schedule request

# **Sanderling** – Mark Schleckser had the following report:

- > Thank you to the Race Committee
- > Fleet said that when there were two courses being run (SPYC & LYC) there were not enough patrol boats on their course.
- > Fleet requested more barrel courses, especially down bay.
- ➤ Maybe afternoon races can start earlier because people are not changing crews like they used to.
- > Class is stable

- Discussion on maybe class dues being included with the BBYRA registration.
- > See attached schedule request

## Sandpiper - Mimi Dimon had the following report:

- Fleet would like to thank the BBYRA for all their efforts this season and wish them good luck in 2011.
- > There is no change to the maximum wind limit.
- > Fleet would like a little variety in the course selections, especially the second race might be a barrel course, not just windward/leeward. Also when there are only a few fleets sailing in the morning (NBYC), they would like longer courses.
- > Fleet would like the BBYRA to continue to announce over the record the boats that are OCS as well as the finish time of the first boat.
- The fleet would like to present the Masters Division trophy at SPYC. The class would monitor the participants, handle the scoring and be responsible for purchasing the plaque.
- > Fleet presented trophies for first, second and third in the Up-Bay and Down-Bay 2010 series. The class will continue these trophies for 2011.
- > The Fleet would like to present the Sandpiper Class Barnegat Bay Trophy to the BBYRA Sandpiper Champion at SPYC. The trophy will list all the class BBYRA Sandpiper Champions since the fleet began racing in the BBYRA. The deed of gift will be submitted shortly. (See picture of trophy attached).
- > Continue with double races with a bye at IHYC and BYC.

# **Sneakbox** – Russ Lines had the following report:

- > Fleet would like no changes
- > Fleet would like to thank the BBYRA for the separate course
- > Fleet would like to sail two races rather than one long course.
- > See attached schedule request.

# **Sunfish** – Kevin Kearney had the following report:

- > Fleet will be sailing one more Saturday this year (NBYC)
- > Fleet had 17 sailors from 6 clubs
- > Junior sailors increased
- > Fleet would like no changes
- > Barrel courses would be fun to sail
- > Adults are discouraging juniors to sail in sunfish.
- > See attached schedule request.

# 420 – Brogan Savage had the following report:

- > Fleet would like to change from college sailing to trap & spinnaker. This change was granted.
- > Fleet would like the same races as last year.
- > Since OCC boats will not be able to be used, courses can be anywhere now. Still it was suggested to launch from TRYC and LYC.

- > If there is no wind the course can be moved.
- > See attached schedule request.

#### **CLASS Rules:**

If a class changes a rule, this change must be stated.

#### **Commodore's Announcements:**

At the Delegates Meeting it was decided to eliminate the Alternate Regatta Representative and instead appoint 7 Regatta Representatives. More people are needed to run the races.

#### **New Business:**

- ➤ Discussion on having downwind finishes on the Starboard side of the Committee Boat.
- > A request was made to have the 4.7 lasers sail with the laser fleet. The November 15 deadline for requesting a new fleet has passed and no request was made.
- > Website should show schedules, news and scores
- ➤ Boats are encouraged to use their name when registering, so that it can be included in the scoring.
- > The BBYRA Ball will be held on June 11, 2011 at MCYC.

**Adjournment** - With no other business to come before the Liaison Committee, Rear Commodore King adjourned the meeting at 12:08 p.m.





The intent of the Sandpiper Fleet is to encourage the members to compete in the Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association.

General qualification and scoring will be the same as the latest BBYRA SI, NOR, etc.

Exceptions to the latest BBYRA rules:

The skipper must be 62 years of age as of the first scheduled Sandpiper BBYRA race and they must actually steer the boat, they cannot crew.

Past Champions of the BBYRA Sandpiper Class for the last five (5) years do not qualify/can not compete as a Master.

Those finishing second (2<sup>nd</sup>) and third (3<sup>rd</sup>) for the last three (3) years do not quality/can not compete as a Master.

The position in the first completed race for that day will be scored for the Masters. The Master Sandpiper BBYRA Champion trophy will be awarded at Annual Sandpiper Fleet meeting. In future years, pending approval, the Champion trophy will be awarded at the BBYRA Annual Awards.

The Sandpiper fleet held its annual meeting on October 2, 2010 and voted to continue with double races with 15 total races scheduled.
