Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association Liaison II Committee Meeting Minutes February 25, 2012 Toms River Yacht Club

<u>Call to Order</u> – Rear Commodore June Kingman called the Liaison II Committee meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. She thanked TRYC for hosting today's meeting.

Roll Call — All classes were present except Laser (absent). Also present: BBYRA flag officers Commodore Ed Reardon, Vice Commodore Bob King, Rear Commodore June Kingman, Fleet Captain Ed Vienckowski, (Treasurer James Maida absent), Secretary Jennifer Alldian and Measurer John Applegate. Past Commodore's present included Richard Proko, Bob Morrow and Jack Heacock, as well as Sailing Instructions Committee Chair Rich Kerdock.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Allan Terhune motioned to approve the Liaison Committee I minutes of November 19, 2011, seconded by Rich Kerdock. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Commodore Ed Reardon thanked everyone for coming and TRYC for hosting the meetings.

Report from US Sailing Committee - Past Commodore Bob Morrow mentioned

- All championships were posted on the US Sailing website.
- The BBYRA Feier Fund will reimburse sailors who venture outside the bay. They must request reimbursement which is either partial or full.
- Junior Chubb Championship will be sailed in San Francisco the first week of August.
- The Area "C" Semi-finals will be sailed at TRYC on July 11, 2012. The NOR are not yet posted on the website.
- The junior women's double handed, Ida Lewis will be sailed in Minnesota in late June (the NOR is posted).
- The junior woman's single handed, Leiter Cup will be sailed in Chicago (the NOR is posted),
- The youth championship will be sailed in Oregon, August 14-18.
- The O'Day will be sailed July 26-29 in Wisconsin (the NOR is not posted).
- The Mallory and Adams will not be sailed this year. They are taking the year off due to lack of participation. They are under construction and looking for suggestions.

<u>Report from Class Eligibility Committee</u> — Committee Chair Ed Vienckowski reported that there were no new classes. The Lightning fleet voluntarily withdrew from the 2012 Championship Series. The Laser Radials will start with the Laser fleet and the Junior Sunfish will start with the sunfish fleet.

Reports to Class Representatives from Regatta II Meeting — Rear Commodore June Kingman reported the following from the Regatta II meeting this morning:

- Championship of Champions will be held at MCYC on Sunday, June 17. The same format as last year and will again be sailed in Sandpipers.
- > Permits have been applied for.
- > Jim Walsh will hold a one day Race Management Seminar.

Chip Hillyer will supply a new green feather flag for that course to replace the one that was lost at the end of last season.

Report from Sailing Instruction Committee -

- > 2012 Weekly Class Schedule (draft attached).
 - Still a few dates to be finalized for Ensign Fleet.

To try to ease the congested AM Green Course Schedule the SI Committee recommends combining Club 420 and Laser/R starts and moving Sunfish from SA to NB.

- > Check in requirement for competitors.
 SI Committee recommends RC fly Code Flag L, to be included in RC Guidelines.
- ➢ Discuss Definition of "Junior" re, Egee Trophy. SI Committee suggests using the definition used by US Sailing for the Youth Championships: less than 19 years old in the calendar year. This definition will be used only for Trophy purposes. Definition of Junior in class rules will still apply for scoring/rules purposes.
- Need some shorter Barrel Courses.
 Opportunities are limited, Down Bay only, but we need to get course sheets in digital format.
- SI Simplification. SI's essentially same as last season. The White Course is gone. Use of a larger font being examined.

Fleet requests:

<u>A Cat</u> – Modify Wind Restriction, would like no start if wind is 20 mph or higher and abandon races if wind increases to 20 mph or higher. Would like a short leeward gate. **OK**

<u>Ensign</u> – Schedule request (*OK need additional schedule clarification*) and opinions on scoring. *Discussion at Liaison Committee meeting indicated the community's desire to leave scoring as it is.*

E Sloops - Request a provisional race schedule modification:

Up Bay - 2 am, 1pm; Down Bay - 1 am, 2 pm races.

An 11:00 hr start is requested for the Down Bay am start

OK RC will provide a 10:50 am Warning.

Flying Scots - Schedule as last year, with week 5 (SAYC) off. OK

<u>Lasers</u> – Need schedule input form Had Brick. *Recommend a schedule that is appropriate for combined Club 420 & Laser/R start.*

<u>Lightnings</u> – Will retire from the bay this year with hope to return in the future. *OK*

M Sloops - Will sail all but Normandy Beach. OK

Sanderlings - Need schedule input. Same schedule as last season.

Sandpipers - Want to cut Toms River & Beachwood, OK

<u>Sneakbox</u> – Return to the Green Course. Want to cut Island Heights and Normandy Beach. Preferences like the Sandpipers. *OK*

<u>Sunfish</u> – Need schedule input, Juniors will start with the Seniors on the Green Course Schedule input received. *SI Committee recommends Sunfish sail NB instead of SA.*

<u>420s</u> – Need schedule input. Recommend a schedule that is appropriate for combined Club 420 & Laser/R start.

New Business:

- 2. According to US Sailing rules, the one minute prep is a long signal. A discussion took place on whether the Ollie with a cannon attached can be used to do that.
