Barnegat Bay Yacht Racing Association Liaison II Committee Meeting Minutes February 23, 2013 Toms River Yacht Club

<u>Call to Order</u> – Rear Commodore June Kingman called the Liaison II Committee meeting to order at 1:37 p.m. Rear Commodore Kingman welcomed everyone and thanked everyone for coming.

Roll Call – All classes were present except A Cat, E Sloop, Sanderling and Sneakbox. Also present: BBYRA flag officers Vice Commodore Bob King, Rear Commodore June Kingman, Fleet Captain Ed Vienckowski, Secretary Jennifer Alldian and Measurer John Applegate (Commodore Ed Reardon and Treasurer James Maida were absent) as well as Past Commodore Rich Proko and Sailing Instructions Committee Chair Rich Kerdock.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Susan Proko motioned to approve the Liaison Committee I minutes of January 2, 2012 seconded by Ed Vienckowski. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

<u>Correspondence</u> – The following correspondence has been received or sent since the January 2 meeting:

 An email from M Sloop Class Representative Susan Rogers, giving Measurer John Applegate her vote.

Report from Sailing Instruction Committee -

- 2013 Weekly Class Schedule (draft attached). Assumes all Upper and Lower Bay Courses are operational and incorporates Fleet schedule requests.
- > To try to ease the congested AM Green Course Schedule the SI Committee recommends combining Club 420 and Sneakbox starts.
- ➤ To further ease AM Green course congestion, determine if any AM fleets (Laser/R?) would switch to PM starting in 2014.
- Examine possible alternatives if: a) courses can't be used, b) if Yacht Clubs are unable to host their Bay Day, c) if a) and/or b) devise methods for advising the Fleets of the alternatives. BBYRA web site will have to post any modification to sailing schedule or venue as soon as practical and fleets must get in the habit of checking the web site for changes. Only P/C Rich Proko can make face book changes and P/C Jack Heacock can make website changes.
- Examine possible alternatives if inadequate RC resources available (Start/Finish/Chase boats) on a Bay Day. With safe sailing in mind, the RC can shorten/abandon races at wind speeds below a fleet's max wind speed, if it is short on chase boats.

> <u>Sailing Instructions</u> - Objective — minimize change due to shortened development interval.

Recommended Changes:

- To ease race course congestion on SPYC race day, E Scows will race on the Wanamaker Course AM & PM.
- Pin end of the Start Line will be a large orange mark.
- Allow RC to make small adjustments to mark locations to maintain proper course configuration
- Rule 10 CHANGING THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE During the race, marks may be repositioned without signal for minor changes in the course. This changes RRS 33. Repositioning marks shall not be grounds for redress.

> Fleet requests

- A Cat Same as last Season, they like to stay on the Green Course. **OK**
- Ensign Schedule requests, expressed concerns about getting 2nd race in, once again suggested that fleets having general recalls go to the back of the line. To improve the likelihood of starting a 2nd race the RC will keep the 1ST race shorter. The RC also has the option of putting a fleet at the end of the starting queue using "AP".
- E Sloops Want to go back to two am and two pm races. Would like if the Up Bay Pink Course be situated further North. Schedule cuts for week 6 & 7. OK
- Flying Scots Schedule as last year, with week 5 (SAYC) off. Request there
 be no 6 leg portable mark courses. OK
- Lasers King boys request race every week, and not share a start. H Brick concerned about Nationals (7/24-28?), it's our bye week. **OK**
- M Sloops Will sail all but Normandy Beach. Request triangles in heavy air, would like to go back to separate downwind start/finish line. RC Handbook includes heavy air triangle request. Start/Finish will remain as last season.
- Sanderlings Same schedule as last season. Want to sail Barrels Down Bay, Portable W/L Up Bay – no Olympic or Triangles. OK
- Sandpipers Same schedule as last season. OK
- Sunfish Schedule, race all but week 5. OK

Report from Regatta Committee II Meeting — Rear Commodore June Kingman reported that Regatta Committee voted to purchase two trailers, one for each course (Rose and Green). Commodore Ed Reardon is in Pennsylvania attending a funeral and could not be with us today.

Fleet Reports

<u>A-Cat</u> – Chip Hillyer submitted no report.

Ensign – Allan Terhune had the following report:

- > The Fleet is concerned since they are a fixed keel boat about going Up Bay with the level of debris. Therefore they would like to make the following changes to the schedule:
 - Drop week 3 at MYC and add a third race at TRYC.
 - They will not be racing on week 1 at BHYC/MCYC or week 5 at SAYC. If they receive a favorable report that the Up Bay is clear of debris, they will sail three races at LYC (week 9).
 - If they have to sail one less race they will in order to be safe.

E-Sloop – Dave Magno submitted no report.

<u>Flying Scot</u> – Rick Kerdock had nothing to report:

Laser - Had Brick had the following report:

- ➤ Requested to be off on July 20, which is the National Sunfish Regatta. A lot of laser sailors also sail Sunfish.
- ➤ Had will ask the fleet if they would be willing to move to PM racing starting in 2014.

M-Sloop – John Applegate was pleased with the schedule.

<u>Sanderling</u> – Brian Harris submitted no report.

Sandpiper - Mimi Dimon had the following report:

- ➤ Fifteen Sandpipers plan to sail this season, 1 is maybe and have not heard from 3.
- > The schedule looks good.

Sneakbox – Art Bailey wanted the same schedule as 2012.

<u>Sunfish</u> – Kevin Kearney said everything looked good.

420 & Junior Sunfish - Susan Proko submitted the following report:

- > They would like no races on June 22 (children will still be in school) and August 3.
- ➤ They will race on June 29 and August 10 (though they requested those dates off also).

New Business:

- > The racing season starts in four months. Contractors have been hired to clear the bay.
- > We are submitting our permit request for a ten week season.
- ➤ Had requested that the web site be better linked to results and photos.
- > A suggestion was made that OCC might have a photo club that was willing to take pictures.
- ➤ Allan Terhune made a motion to hire Tricia Murphy at \$100 a week for 10 weeks to take photos. John Applegate seconded this motion. The motion was approved to be brought to the Delegate Committee.
- > A discussion followed on the need for patrol boats and a reminder that this is a volunteer organization.
- ➤ Had made a motion that the BBYRA consider hiring a photographer to photography the races and events throughout the year. Kevin Kearney seconded this motion. This motion was denied.
- A motion was made by Ed Vienckowski that Had Brick Chair the Publicity Committee, that will record events of the Bay and the images will be up loaded to the web site. Mimi Dimon seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
- ➤ Allan Terhune said that Had Brick should define the guidelines and rules of the Publicity Committee and bring to the Delegate Meeting in April.

<u>Adjournment</u> - With no other business to come before the Liaison Committee, a motion was made by Ed Vienckowski to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mimi Dimon and Kevin Kearney and at 2:34 the meeting was adjourned.

2013 E SCOW BBYRA REPORT

The fleet has met and we have come up with five (5) suggestions in order of priority.

The top matters for the fleet are course location and water depth. The two (2) issues are often intertwined depending on wind direction. Our proposed solution (except for Seaside which will continue to be sailed on the Wanamaker course) is to switch venues to the opposite side of the bridge. On Up Bay weeks we can be put anywhere from Wanamaker to Seaside depending on the conditions. On Down Bay weeks we can be put anywhere from Green Island to South Mantoloking depending on weather. The entire fleet tows to the races so the venue switch is practical.

Should the venue switch not be approved; then the course locations need to change. I've sailed at Lavallette over numerous years and can tell you that unless the water is high, E boats will hit bottom south of Q barrel. Our Up Bay courses need to go north to either Green Island or South Mantoloking/Normandy. The Seaside course is tight because of water depth. However, the course needs to be stretched to the maximum to avoid pile-ups at the marks.

Since we are isolated (no fleet wants to sail with us), we propose a shorter lunch break. Our proposal is that after the final boat finishes the last morning race, the afternoon warning shall be one (1) hour later, but not before noon. In this manner a boat only sailing the afternoon series would know when to arrive.

Why do we still sail only one (1) race at Seaside? Computer scoring should remedy previous time constraints. Even sailing one (1) longer race often leaves significant down time (sometimes three hours between morning and afternoon).

The Black Flag should not be used until there is at least two (2) general recalls because of the severe penalty. The I Flag used immediately is fine, and the race committee should start recalling OCS boats within the last minute. The positive aspect of the early identifications would be to decrease the probability of a general recall. Also, use of the Z Flag penalty after a general recall is encouraged.

2014 BBYRA Championship Series Change Requests

- A. The Sunfish Fleet would like eight Saturdays of racing in 2014. They will take off from racing on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays. Two (2) afternoon races on all Down Bay Saturdays and an afternoon race at Seaside Park. For the remaining Up Bay Saturdays, two (2) morning races each at Shore Acres, Normandy Beach and Lavallette. To summarize: No Races on the 1st & 3rd Saturdays. Down Bay afternoons. Up Bay mornings.
- B. Triangles, triangles, triangles. The Sunfish Fleet requests race courses using portable marks in a triangular configuration. Many fleet members have expressed their desire to race Sunfish on triangular courses. Other fleets benefit tactically racing downwind on W/L courses. Not the Sunfish. The configuration of the Sunfish lateen sail rig makes for an enormously favored starboard gybe straight downwind. So much so, unless the course is severely skewed (which rarely happens) or a dramatic wind shift has occurred the downwind port gybe is avoided. W/L courses produce a dull, uneventful, downwind starboard gybe parade to the leeward mark. Triangular courses will provide tactical maneuvers for the Sunfish Fleet not available to the boat on a W/L course.
- C. Barrel Courses are also desired. The Ralph Bush Trophy race during week 6 has been suggested as a good race for a Barrel Course.
- D. Top end wind parameters at 22 mph are fine. We would appreciate the low end wind, to start a race, to be not less than 2 mph.
