I he first duckboat was built by Hazelton Seamon at West Creek New Jersey, on Barnegat Bay in 1836. Today the Duckboat is not a racing class and almost extinct. That will change with this year's Duckboat Worlds 2000. To rekindle interest in this dying breed of boats each entrant who refurbishes a boat and races it will be eligible for a \$5000 donation to his or her charity or to a junior sailing program on Barnegat Bay. Any boat in a garage or boat yard which is refurbished and considered to be in "Bristol condition" may enter this year's competition.
