### Sewell Cup Race Today

SEA SIDE PARK, N. J., Aug. 13.—The Sewell cup race—known as “the blue ribbon event” in upper Barnegat Bay yachting—takes place tomorrow at this resort. The prize is a handsome silver cup given by the late General William Joyce Sewell, United States Senator from New Jersey, to be raced for perpetually on the second Saturday in August. The races are open to yachts sailed by amateurs from the Sea Side Park, Island Heights and Bay Head Clubs. So far Bay Head has not produced a winner. The cup has been sailed for nine times, four times won by Sea Side Park and five times by Island Heights. It has been twice taken by Mina, Bouquet and Empress, once by Another Old Maid, Manhasset and I. H. Y. C. Tomorrow it is likely that the only contestants will be Manhasset and I. H. Y. C., as these two boats have the other racing craft in the bay left far behind in the matter of speed. I. H. Y. C. will be sailed by Dr. Al Mulford, the University of Pennsylvania football player and coach. Manhasset will be commanded by Herman Muller, of the municipal law department of Philadelphia.
