

**BIG REGATTA UNDER WAY
IN BARNEGAT BAY TODAY.**

ISLAND HEIGHTS, Aug. 21.—The Inquirer regatta was held in lower Barnegat bay today. With nerves tingling at the prospect of the greatest day of racing ever seen along the North Jersey coast, and keyed up to the minute for the thrilling races, yachtsmen of Barnegat bay and Tom's River tucked themselves off to bed early last night to awaken at dawn today for the mammoth Philadelphia Inquirer regatta for power and sail boats of the Island Heights, Sea Side Park, Bay Head, Mantoloking, Toms River, Barnegat City, Cedar, Lavallette, Corinthian Yacht and Gun and Forked River clubs.

Probably the yachtsmen of these waters, who are to compete together for the first time in the history of yachting in this part of New Jersey, never put in a more strenuous and exciting twenty-four hours than yesterday.

The various classes, together with the order in which they will be raced, follow:

- 11:05 a. m.—Speed power boats.
- 11:10 a. m.—Cruising power boats.
- 11:15 a. m.—Open launches.
- 1:30 p. m.—Sneak boxes, under 20 feet.
- 1:35 p. m.—Single centreboard cat-boats.
- 1:55 p. m.—Cabin cruising sloops.
- 2 p. m.—Open sloop, including double centreboards.
